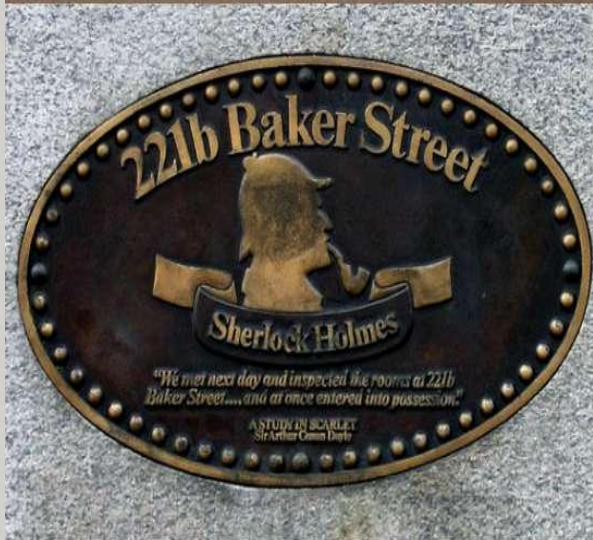
So, I want to share my three favorite places

I love British tea

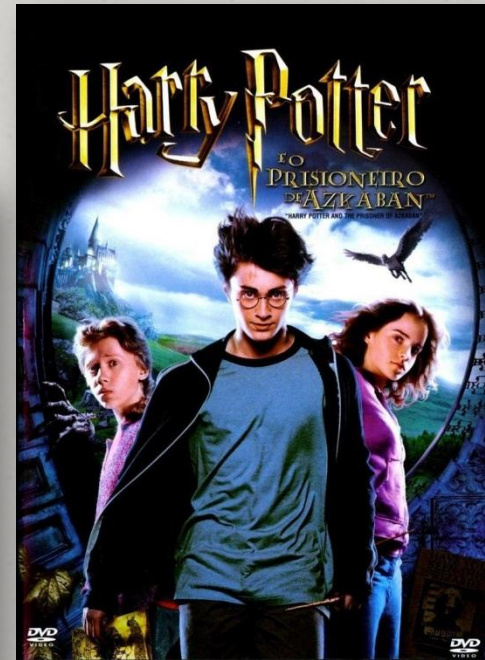
