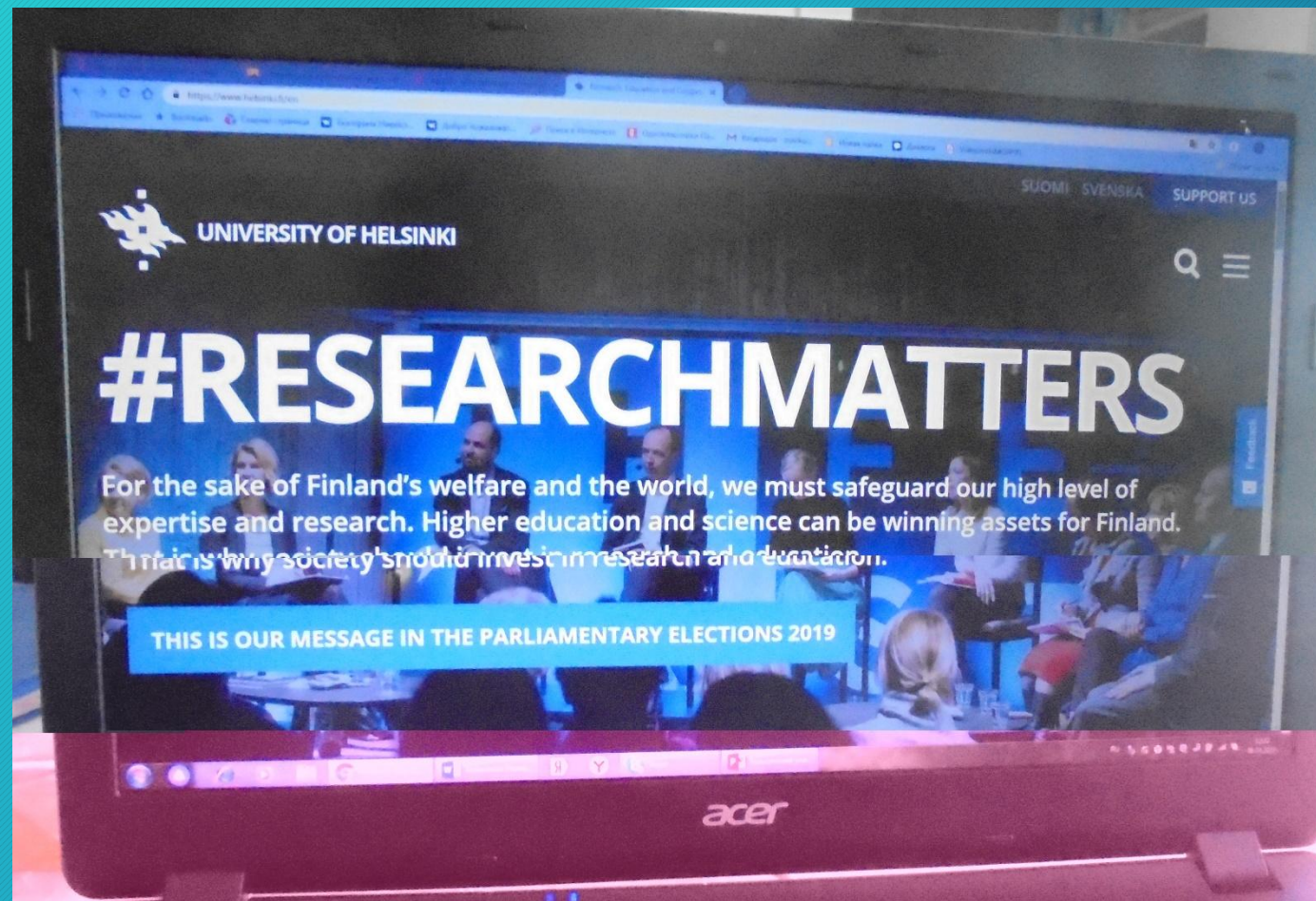

History of creation

Helsinki University - Helsingin yliopisto - the largest University in Finland, founded in the port city of Turku, and later moved to the capital of the country - Helsinki. It was opened in 1640 and is famous as the oldest educational institution in the country.





The University of Helsinki has a General profile of education, the program lacks only a business direction. Along with such prestigious institutions as Bologna and Coimbra universities, Helsinki University is part of the European Association "Utrecht network"

Advantages of Helsinki University

The strongest research areas of the University of Helsinki are three faculties. The main pride of the institution is its faculty of Humanities, in particular the study of philosophy, linguistics, anthropology and media.

The faculty of natural Sciences is famous for its programs in the field of ecology and agriculture. It also conducts global studies in the field of ecology of the Baltic sea and its biodiversity.



Requirements for admission to the University of Helsinki

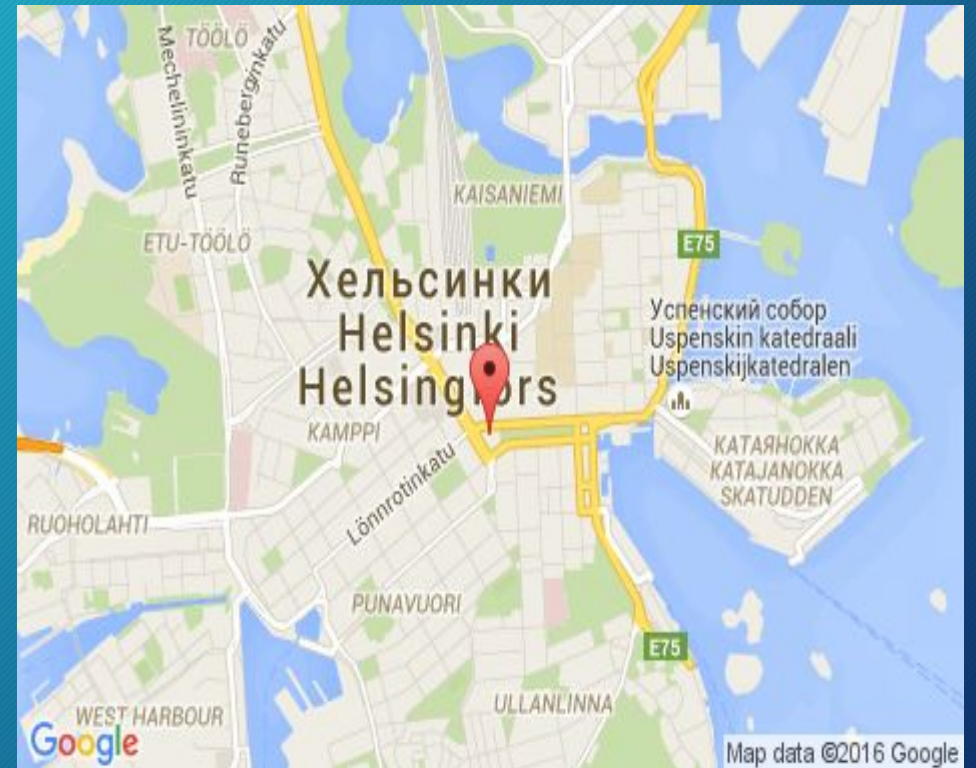
- For admission to the University of Helsinki it is necessary to submit a document on education in Finnish, English or Swedish.
- Along with the application for admission, you must send a motivation letter, CV and recommendation letters from the previous place of study.
- For admission to bachelor's programmes, applicants take entrance examinations at the University of Helsinki. The exam program depends on the direction and is usually available on request.
- To study at the University of Helsinki in English, the applicant must confirm his / her knowledge of English.
- Students must pay a registration fee of €100 when applying for a course.

Arrangement of the University of Helsinki

The University is located in the heart of Helsinki, West of Senate square. The campus is divided into four large parts according to the four main faculties.

The national library and the University Museum are located next to the University.

High chances of enrollment. When applying to top universities abroad, you compete with the strongest students from different countries.



Interesting facts about the University of Helsinki

- The University of Helsinki can be proud of its graduates. Among them are numerous Nobel prize winners, including in such fields as chemistry, physics and literature.
- 7 out of 11 Finnish presidents graduated from the University of Helsinki.
- In honor of the 350th anniversary of the University of Helsinki, his name was given to the rhododendron flower.
