# Tips for job interview

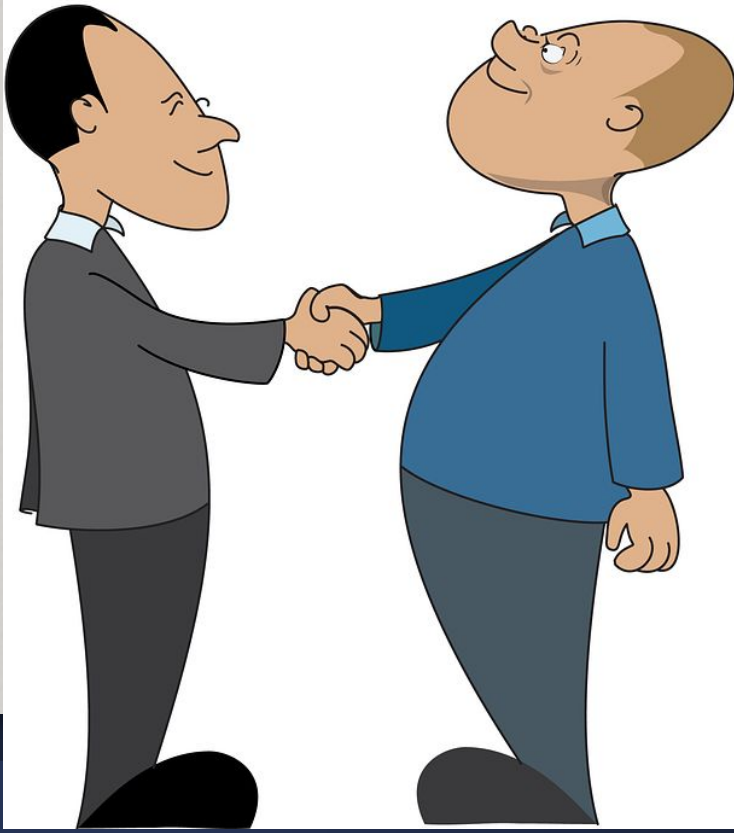
## Five positive tips for job interview
