VALENTINE'S DAY

IT'S ALWAYS GOOD TO GIVE A CARD ON VALENTINE'S DAY, BUT A HOMEMADE ONE IS ALWAYS BETTER! HERE ARE A FEW IDEAS TO GET STARTED. LOOK TO THE BOTTOM OF THE PAGE FOR SUPPLIES YOU'LL NEED.



HEART CARD

1

CUT A LARGE RED HEART FOR THE MAIN PART OF THE CARD.

CUT ONE LARGE WHITE HEART SLIGHTLY SMALLER
THAN THE FIRST.

FOLD A PIECE OF CONSTRUCTION PAPER IN HALF LENGTHWISE.

CUT OUT HALF A HEART SHAPE FREEHAND OR USE_A
HEART_TEMPLATE.

UNFOLD BOTH HEARTS AND GLUE THE WHITE ONE
INSIDE THE RED ONE.

DECORATE THE CARD ANY WAY YOU PLEASE.



TO MAKE YOUR POP-UP VALENTINE'S DAY CARD, YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING: CARD-STOCK RED PAPER (OR CONSTRUCTION PAPER), CARD-STOCK WHITE PAPER (OR CONSTRUCTION PAPER), A RED PEN OR THIN MARKER, A PENCIL, SCISSORS, GLUE, AND A RULER.



STEP 2: CUT A SHEET OF WHITE PAPER IN HALF.



STEP 3: FOLD EACH PIECE OF PAPER IN HALF TO FORM A CARD.



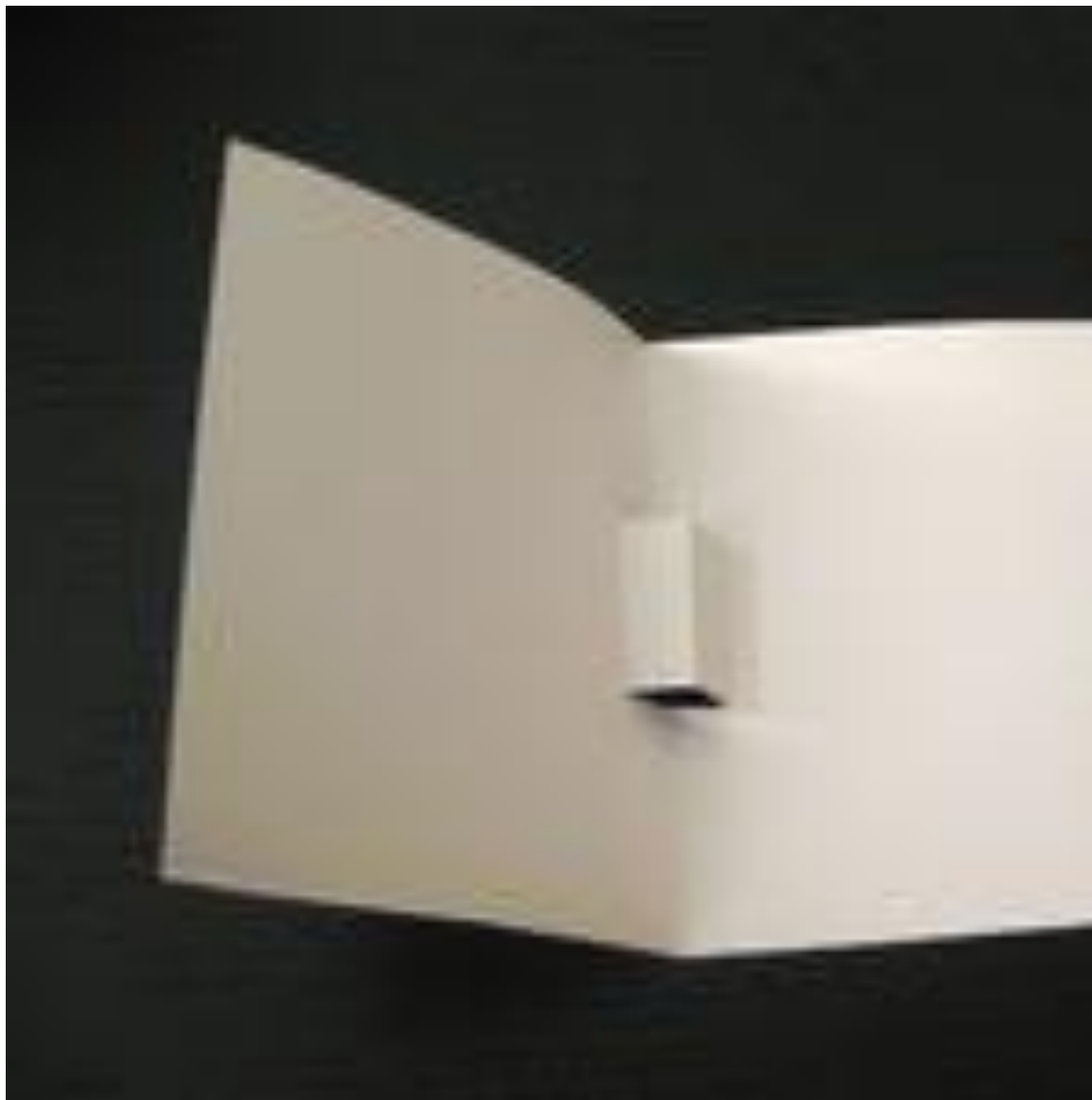
STEP 4: MAKE TWO CENTER LINES.



STEP 5: CUT AND FOLD ALONG LINES.



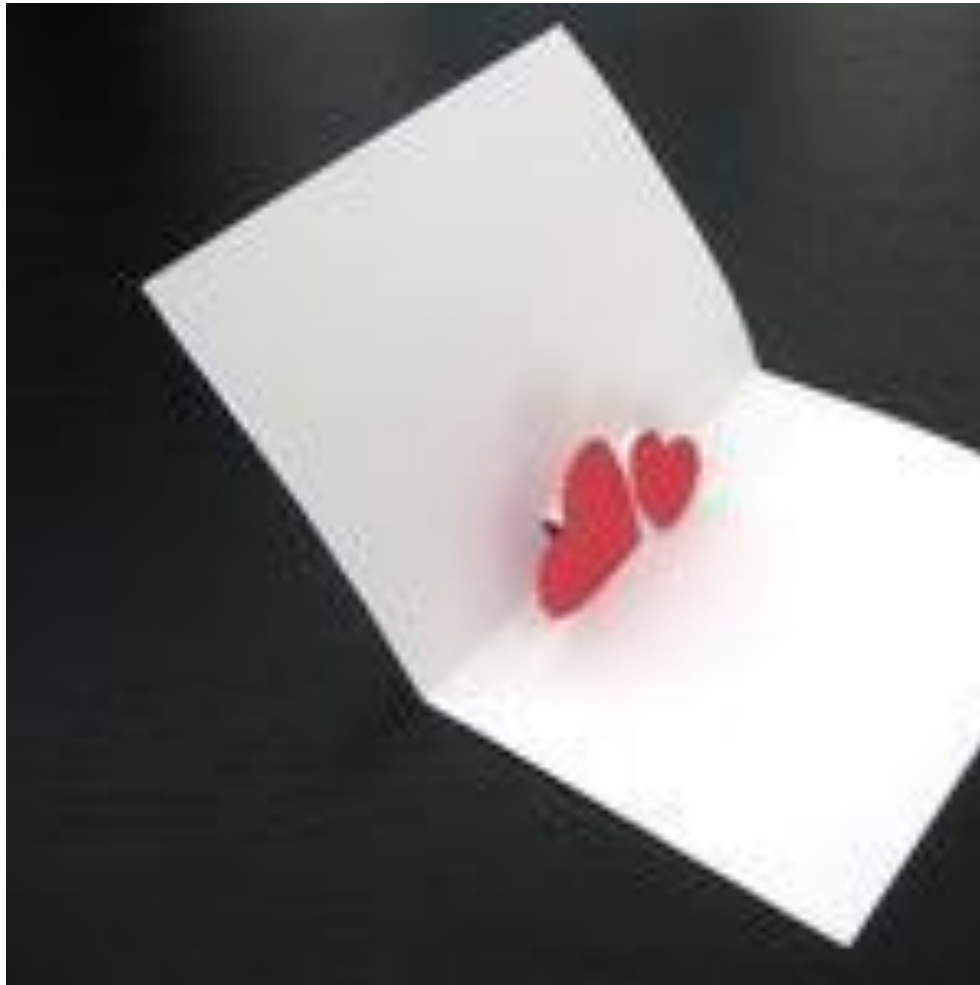
STEP 6: OPEN THE CARD.



STEP 7: CUT OUT RED HEARTS.



STEP 8: GLUE ON THE TWO SMALL HEARTS.



STEP 9: YOUR HEARTS WILL NOW POP.



STEP 10: GLUE ON THE BIG HEART AND WRITE YOUR COVER MESSAGE.



STEP 11: WRITE YOUR VALENTINE'S DAY GREETING INSIDE THE CARD.

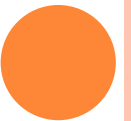
