

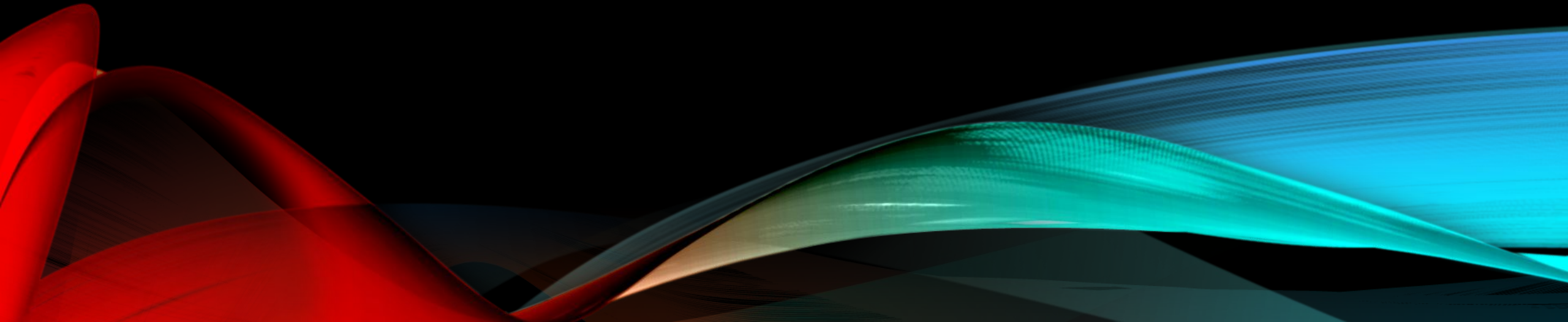

BIOGRAPHY

Nadezhda Viktorovna was born on December 29, 1956 in Votkinsk, Udmurt Republic. Nadezhda Viktorovna was a hyperactive child, at the age of 3 she was put on skis, she fell in love with physical culture

When Nadezhda was 12, she fell unsuccessfully at the city skating rink, initially she did not pay attention to back pain, and at the age of 20 her legs failed



COMING INTO THE SPORT

Started with athletics, the first coach Kuznetsov Valentin Georgievich, who instilled faith in her kind word, in 92 she became the champion of Russia in athletics for persons with a defeat of the musculoskeletal apparatus



it became difficult Kuznetsov advised swimming or table tennis, she began to address them in parallel, in '93, she became the champion of Russia in swimming in 96, the championship of Russia in table tennis and swimming were held in parallel and she chose tennis



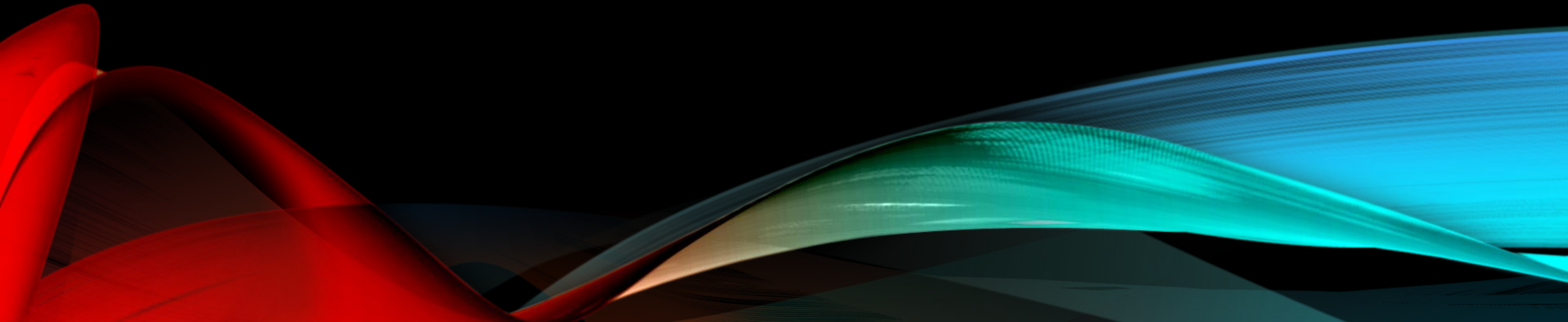
MODERNITY
