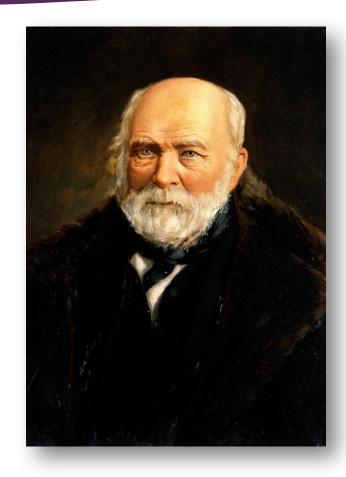
## What qualities you need to have for the profession of doctor? (Knowledge)

- To be responsible and responsive

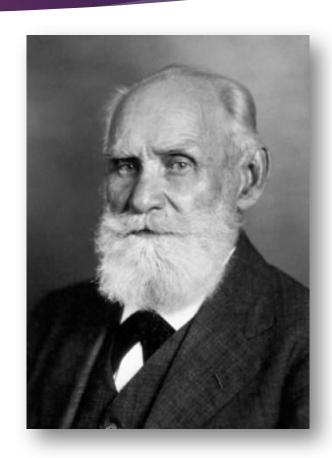


### Famous personalities

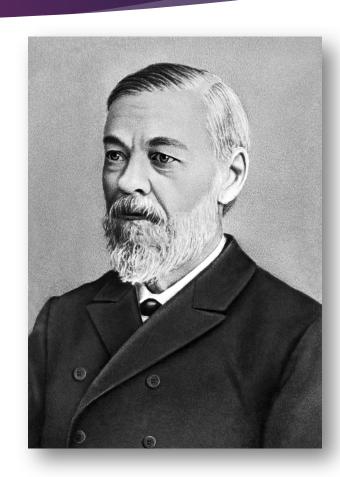
Nikolay Ivanovich Pirogov,
world-famous doctor. He is
considered to be the founder of field
surgery, and was one of the first
surgeons in Europe to use ether as
an anaesthetic. He was the first
surgeon to use anaesthesia in a field
operation



# ► Ivan Petrovich Pavlov. Russian physiologist known chiefly for his development of the concept of the conditioned reflex. He was awarded the Nobel Prize for Physiology or Medicine in 1904 for his work on digestive secretions.



► Ivan Sechenov. He studied in Germany, conducted long-term experiments, and became the first Russian specialist in physiology, giving the discipline the serious scientific basis. His fundamental work "Reflexes of the Brain" remains a milestone in neuroscience and the study of reflexes.



### Interesting facts

- Doctors did not wear white coats until 1800
- The first liver transplant was performed by Thomas Starlz in 1967
- The first human head transplant was performed on a corpse
- More than 7000 Americans die every year as a result of the bad handwriting of doctors
