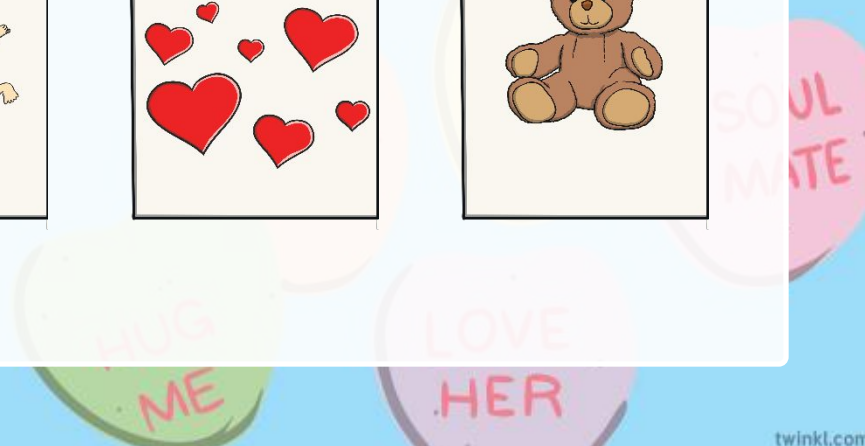
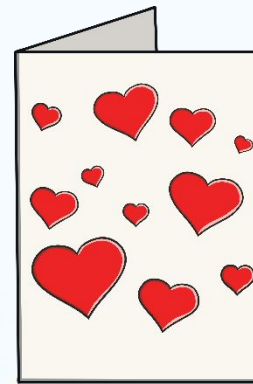


5 Pretty Valentines

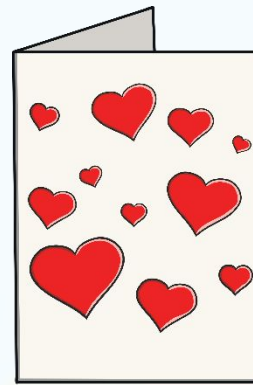

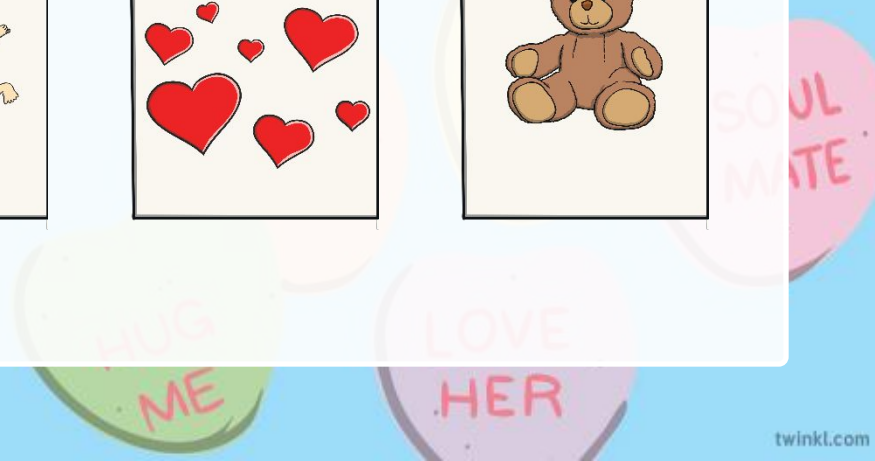
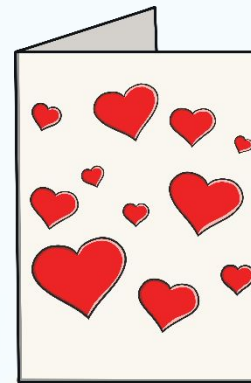
Five pretty valentines resting on the floor,
(Child's name) bought one and then there were four.



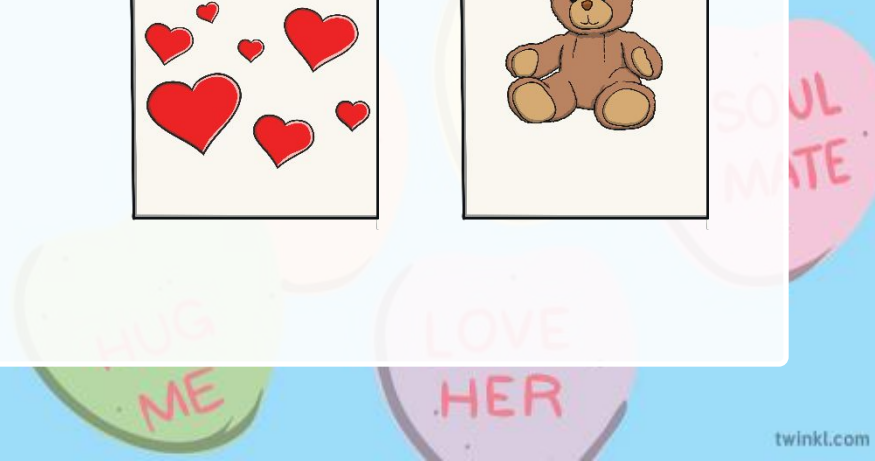
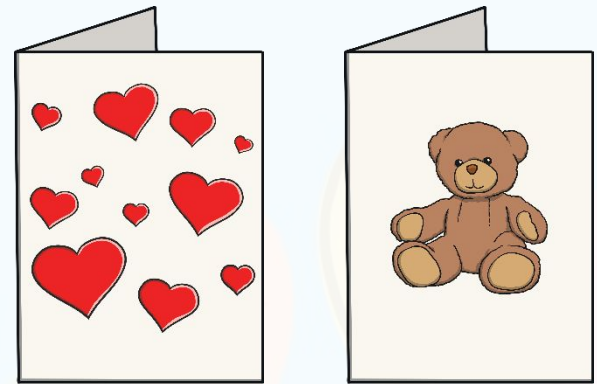
Four pretty valentines shaped like a V,
