

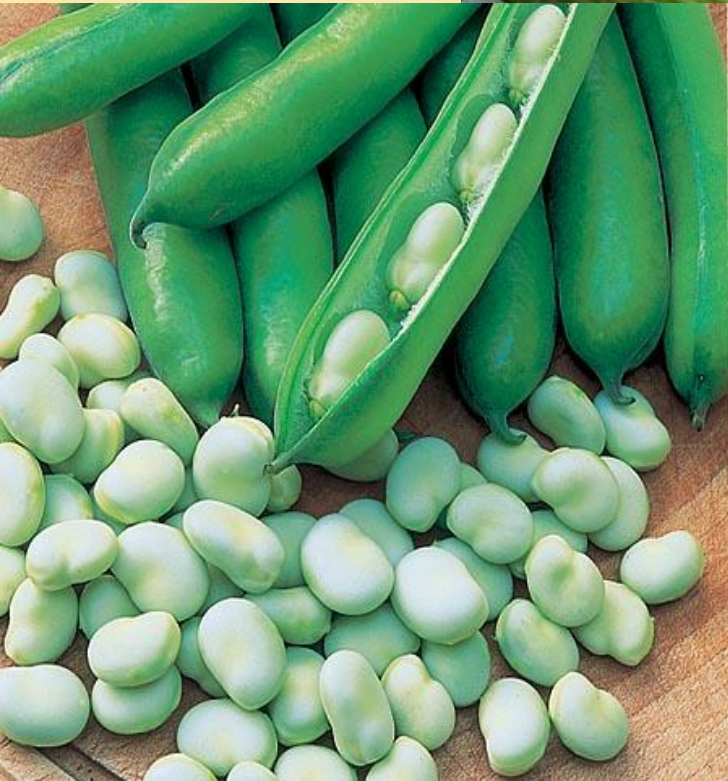

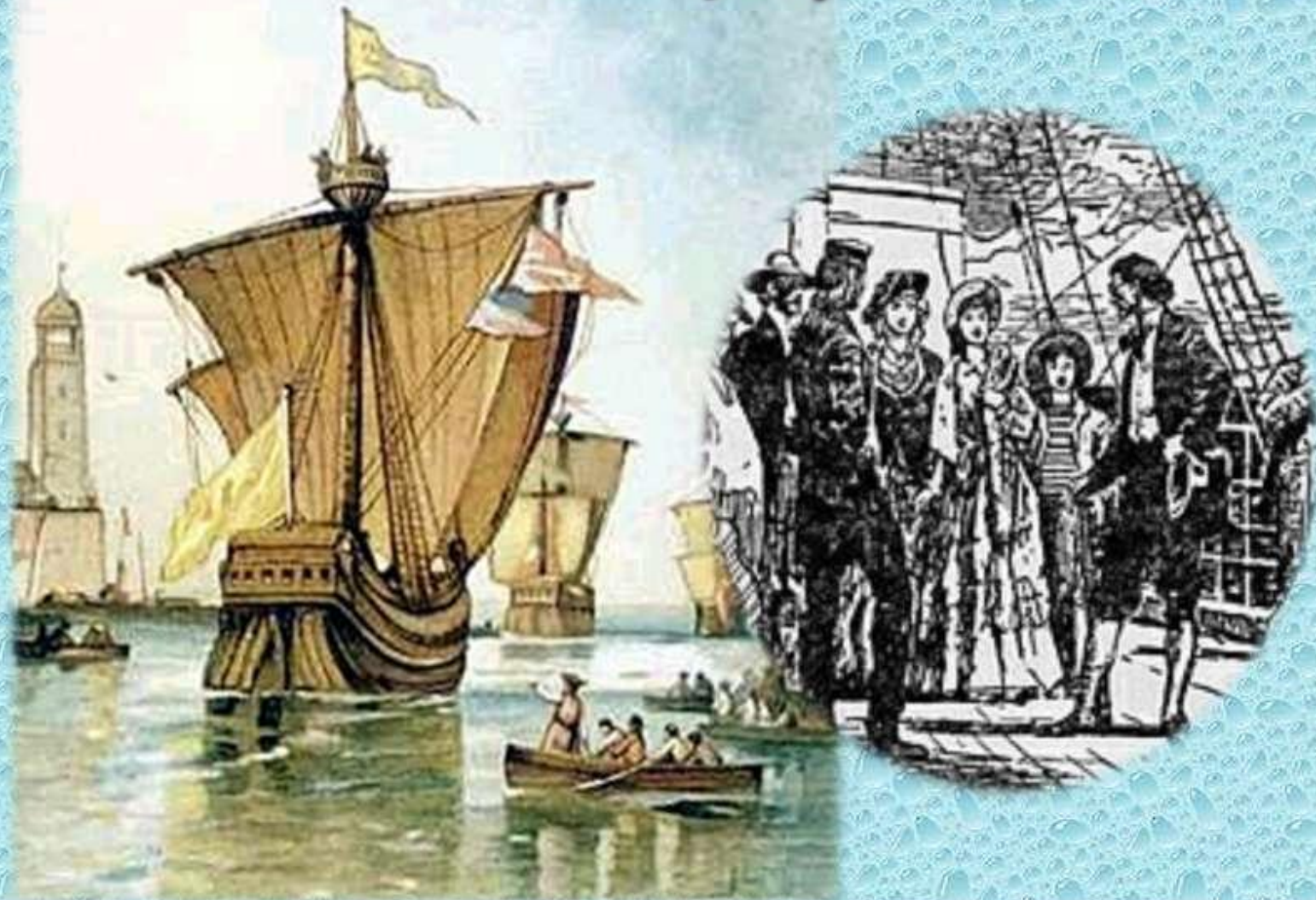


First Thanksgiving day

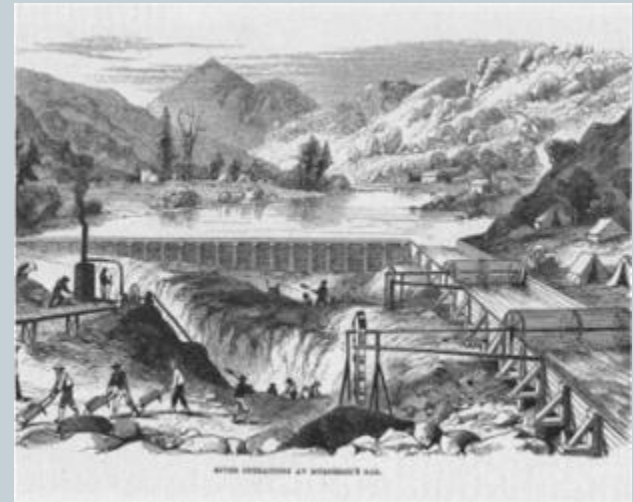






First winter

The first Thanksgiving dinner 11) lasted for three days.

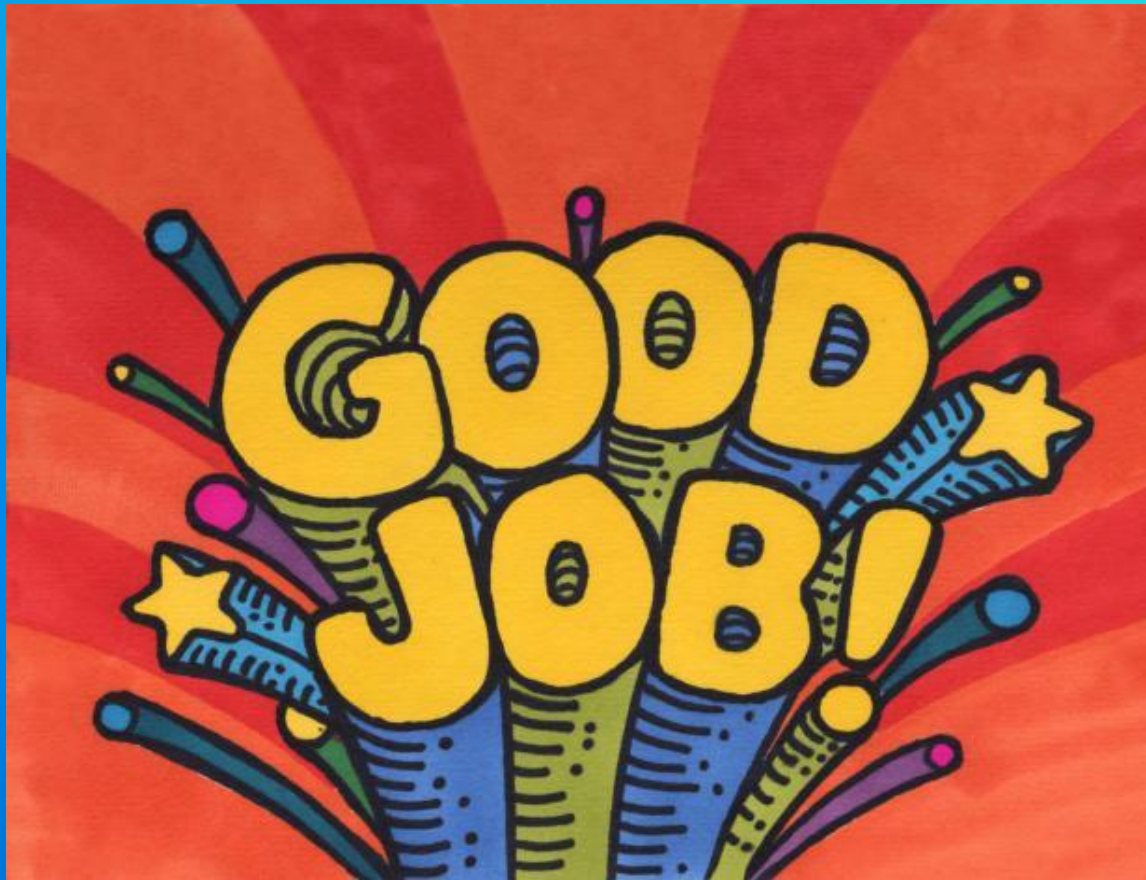
