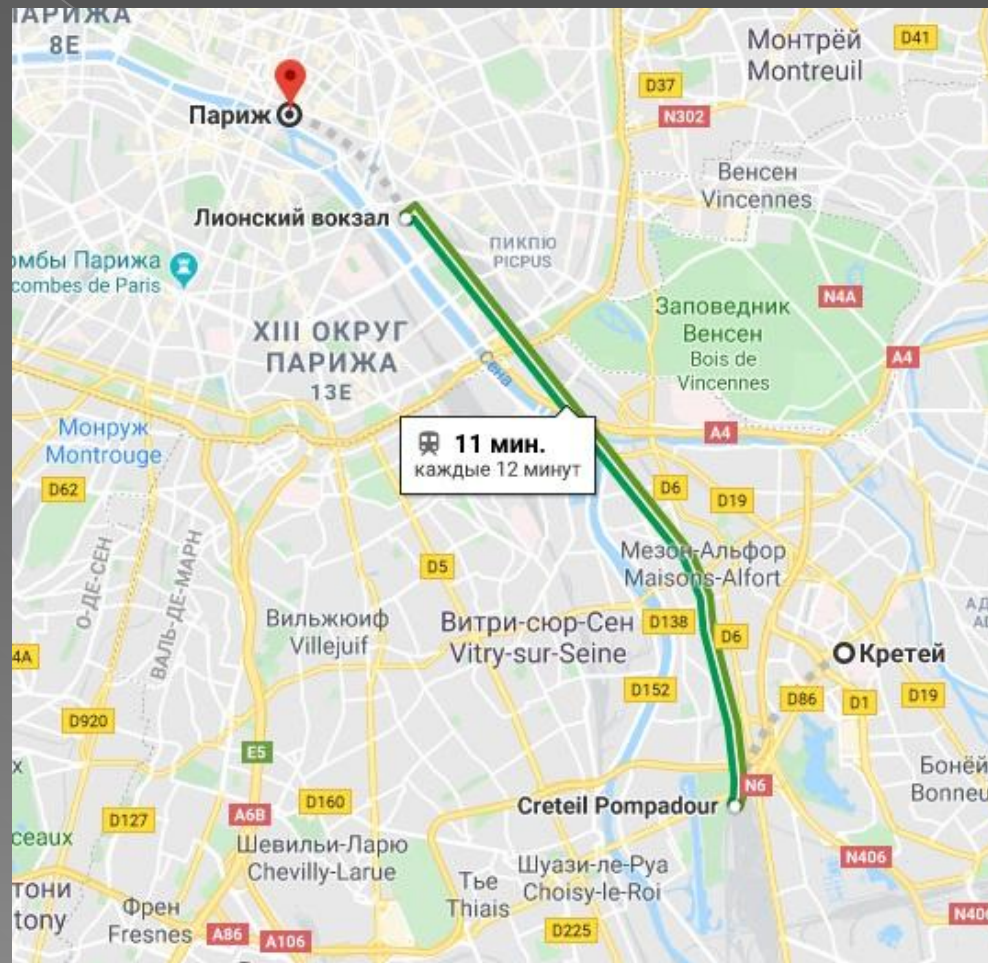
**Créteil** is a commune in the southeastern suburbs of Paris, France. It is located 11.5 km (7.1 mi) from the centre of Paris.

# Paris subway

- ◉ It is the [second-busiest metro system](#) in [Europe](#), after the [Moscow Metro](#), as well as the tenth-busiest in the world. It carried 1.520 billion passengers in 2015,<sup>[2]</sup> 4.16 million passengers a day, which amounts to 20% of the overall traffic in Paris. It is one of the densest metro systems in the world, with 245 stations within the 86.9 km<sup>2</sup> (34 sq mi) of the city of Paris. [Châtelet–Les Halles](#), with five Métro lines, three [RER commuter rail](#) and platforms up to 800 m apart, is one of the world's largest metro stations.

# Food

- ◉ bread - from 1 to 3 euros
- ◉ milk - about 4 € per liter
- ◉ cheese - a kilogram will cost 20-30 euros
- ◉ meat: the cheapest chicken - from 10 euros, pork - from 13 €, beef - 20-25 €. fish - 20-30 euros per 1 kg sausages - an average of 7 to 50 euros.
- ◉ eggs (for a dozen) - 4 euros
- ◉ juices - 2-3 euros per liter
- ◉ soda - from 1 euro per liter
- ◉ alcohol - from 5 euros for wine, cognac - from 20 euros / liter
- ◉ fruits - from 3 euros, the most expensive berries vegetables - from 2 euros per kilogram
- ◉ Food prices in the markets In markets, prices are much lower than in supermarkets, for example: a kilogram of fish costs about 10-15 euros, cheese - from 5 euros.

# Food

- Restaurants: A complex lunch in a modest Parisian restaurant will cost 10-15 €, if you eat in the center of the capital, you will pay about 15-25 €. a multi-course dinner with a glass of wine costs approximately 45 €. a cup of good coffee - from 3 to 6 € lovers of sweets will need to cook 4-6 € per piece of cake. fast food is cheaper: about 3 € per sandwich.
- Café: meat and fish dishes - from 14 € first courses, salads, desserts 8-10 €.



# Entertainment

- ◉ Examples of ticket prices for popular museums Orsay Museum ticket price: 12. EUR museums and exhibition = 16.
- ◉ Louvre Museum = 15 EUR
- ◉ Notre Dame Cathedral - Free,
- ◉ Saint-Chapelle (Holy Chapel) = 11 EUR
- ◉ Various entertainments and shows:
- ◉ The Eiffel Tower (ticket to the very top); 2,1 USD = 17 EUR for adults
- ◉ Luxembourg Gardens - Free
- ◉ Dance show in Moulin Rouge, price depends on time. Inexpensive ticket for 9 pm costs = 105. EUR Entrance to a nightclub 30 EUR (Usually 1-2 drinks are included in the price)
