Lionel Messi started playing football at a very young age for the club of his city "Newells Old Boys". At the age of 11, he moved with his parents to Barcelona, where, at the age of 13, he was in the youth team of FC Barcelona and in his first match he signed up for poker, and in just a season he punched 37 goals in 30 matches. Messi quickly found his game and began to often appear in the starting line-up of the second team, on average, scoring the ball for the game. At the age of 16, the game of Lionel was noted by Fabio Capello; he invited the head coach of the team, Frank Rijkaard, to take Messi in rent for the season

In 2005 and 2007-2013, 2015-2016. Was recognized as the best player of the year in Argentina, the last eight awards were awarded to the best Argentine abroad. In 2007, 2009, 2010 and 2011 was recognized as the best player in the championship of Spain. In 2009, he was voted the best player of the year in European club football by the UEFA version and the best striker of the Champions League.

In the same year he received the "Golden Ball" as the best footballer in Europe and the "Diamond Ball" as the best football player in the world according to FIFA. The best footballer of the world in 2010 (became the first owner of the "Golden Ball of FIFA", the combined prize from "France Football" and FIFA). In 2011, Messi became the best player in Europe (the first winner of the prize for the best footballer of the year in Europe) and the owner of the "FIFA Golden Ball". In 2012, he became the first player to receive the "FIFA Golden Ball" three times. Three-time winner of the Golden Boots (2010, 2012 and 2013).

On October 3, 2000, Barcelona's sports director Carles Rexach saw little Messi in action and immediately invited him to sign a contract. Paper was not at hand, and Carles sketched the text of the contract on a napkin. The club paid for the treatment of Lionel and moved his family to Spain. Messi joined the youth team of "Barcelona" and began training at the football academy "La Masia". At that time, the coach of Juventus Fabio Capello offered Barcelona to buy Messi for a lucrative amount, but he was denied.
