DIRECTIONS FOR PLAY:

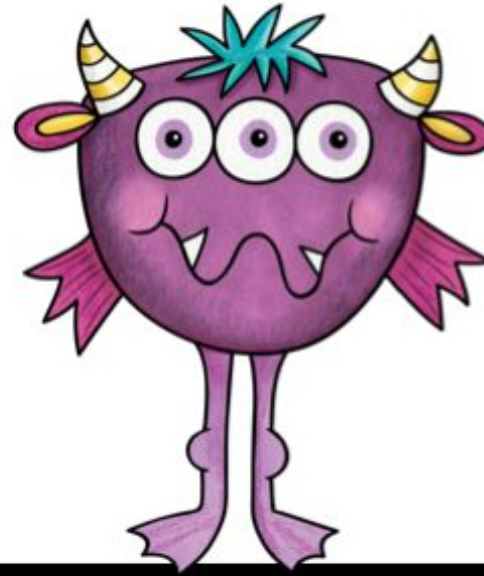
- 1) Print, laminate, and cut out the fact cards.
- 2) When ready to play, distribute one card to each child. If you have less than 25 students, you may want to give a few students more than one or include yourself in distribution.
- 3) Play begins when the student with the first card reads his card. Students listen for a subtraction fact that equals the first number on their cards. When a student hears his fact read, he then reads his card. Play continues until the last card is read.
- 4) My students like to exchange cards with friends and play the game 2 to 3 times.
