



BE GOING TO



USE

We use BE GOING TO to talk about future plans and intentions.

FORM

Subject+be+going to+infinitive

AFFIRMATIVE

I am going to wash cars.

You are going to wash cars.

He / She / It is going to wash cars.

We / You / They are going to wash cars.

NEGATIVE

I am not going to buy a pen.

You aren't going to buy a pen.

He / She / It isn't going to buy a pen.

We / You / They aren't going to buy a pen.

QUESTIONS AND SHORT ANSWERS

Am I going to work?

Yes, I am.

No, I'm not.

Are you going to work?

Yes, you are.

No, you aren't.

Is he / she / it going to work?

Yes, he / she / it is.

No, he / she / it isn't.

Are we / you / they going to work?

Yes, we / you / they are.

No, we / you / they aren't.
