

WhoDunit?

- After data is collected, each expert will share with the group all data, facts, and information gathered.
- As a group, you will then analyze the data and begin the process of eliminating suspects who do not meet all the criteria of the profile set forth in the case.
 - Ask yourself the following questions:
 - Which authors match the criteria of the criminal in question?
 - What characteristics and past experiences/situations cause these famous authors to fit the profile? What are their motives?
 - Is the criminal author leading me astray with red herrings?

Staying Safe in the Sun

Since you are worried about your own safety and the safety of others in Sunnville, you want to learn as much as you can about the dangers of the sun and how to protect your skin. You do not want to keep this information a secret, so you will have to tell others what you learn.

- Your first mission is to find as much information as you can about the dangers of the sun.
- Second, find ways that will help protect your skin while having fun outdoors.
- Finally write an article for the Sunnville Times that tells others the importance of staying safe in the sun.

Веб-квести бувають:

- груповими, парними та індивідуальними;
- короткостроковими (1-3 заняття) та довгостроковими (до декількох місяців);

У викладанні іноземних мов веб-квести слугують для:

• навчання усного та писемного мовлення;

- розвитку умінь читання та аудіювання;
- розширення лексико-граматичного запасу учнів.

Оскільки <u>практичною метою</u> використання веб-квестів є навчання усного чи писемного мовлення, вони, як правило, застосовуються <u>на останніх заняттях</u> вивчення теми.

Under Sea Aventures

Task

You and your classmates have been selected to be star reporters for Sea World. You will be working in groups of four. Each team member will research and report on a different shark. The sharks you will be reporting on are:

Great White Shark Blue Shark Hammerhead Shark Whale Shark

Each team member will be researching a different shark. Team members will visit several websites to gather information about their sharks. There will be a list of shark questions that team members much research. The answers to these questions will be the basis for the magazine articles. Team members must draw a picture of their shark to include in the article. The articles and pictures from each team member will be compiled and published in the Sea World magazine, *Under Sea Adventures*.

Attendance at many of America's national parks is on the decline and the U.S. National Park Service needs your help. It seems that people would rather jet off to exotic locations than take advantage of the beauty that is in their own backyard. To help boost attendance and to expose Americans to some of our nation's greatest treasures, you will create an exciting advertising campaign for the park of your choice.

Your **ADventure** begins by independently exploring various websites to discover persuasive techniques used in advertising. After you have mastered the art of persuasion, you will work with a partner to develop an advertising campaign for one of America's national parks. As a team, you will use the links provided and other Internet sites to research the national park of your choice. Once you are satisfied with your information, you will create an advertising package that consists of an appealing, colorful advertisement and a 60-second commercial that highlights your park's biggest attractions.

Task

The task for this project is to form a group of three to four people and 1.) create a Georgia fact book 2.) create a poster map of the state of Georgia 3.) make a travel brochure with three or more places to visit in Georgia and 4.) write a letter to the Governor of Georgia providing him with suggestions on how to increase tourism and why the economy is not thriving. This may take a lot of time, so each member will be responsible for one of the four tasks. For the fourth task, however, everyone is required to participate. Each member must provide some insight or knowledge for the letter while the final group member who did not perform any of the previous tasks is in charge of putting it together into a one and a half to two page paper.

The Quest(ion) / Task

Instead of looking at the Tuskegee Study and saying, "That was bad," if we are to really learn from the experience and avoid things like it in the future, we must be clear about what made the Tuskegee Study so tragic. To gain this understanding, you and a team of fellow students will look at several aspects of the Tuskegee Study and then turn your focus to other topics that have been compared to it. Your task is to thoroughly understand key issues involved in the Study, analyze articles that compare other tragedies to the Tuskegee Study, and, finally, write your critiques to the authors of the articles. To get very specific about it, in this WebQuest you will answer the question:

Is the Tuskegee Study unique or are the same kind of tragedies happening all around us?

To help you answer this question, you'll do three main things:

- Read online articles about Tuskegee Study and a few other controversial topics.
- 2. Analyze the similarities and differences between the other topics and the Tuskegee Study.
- 3. Write an intelligent comment to the authors and send it via email.

First, students will choose two brands of products with similarities to compare (examples: Coke vs. Pepsi, Papa Johns vs. Domino's, XBox vs. PS2, etc) Second, students will research both subjects, its various elements, and its accepted interpretations. Then, with that understanding, students will form their own opinion and create a persuasive speech synthesizing this information and their views for their given audience.

The Task: Your Case



In order to solve this case, you will work with your fellow detectives in teams to research the suspects, analyze the clues, develop hypotheses, test your theories, and solve the crime. Your team must then (1) prove your solution to your fellow detectives by composing a persuasive argument, supported by your research, thoroughly explaining every detail and piece of evidence, the motive, and the chronological events of the crime. You will also (2) formulate a unique way to present your replay of the crime. Finally, you will (3) write, individually, a brief synopsis of your detective procedures. The team's research-based argument and each individual's brief synopsis of procedures will be posted to the class website for critique by your fellow junior detectives.

The U.S. Treasury Department has approved the minting of a new \$2 coin to help boost the economy. Because of your interest and knowledge of U.S. history, they have chosen fourth grade students to research and design this new coin. There are a few guidelines that must be followed in order for your coin to pass final approval. These requirements must be followed or the design will not be coined by the U.S. Mint.

1. Heads

On the front of the coin, the person/or persons on the coin must be a historical figure important to U.S. history. It cannot be someone who is still living. You may choose another graphic to enhance the overall appearance, but the person should be the focal point of this side of the coin.

2. Tails

On the back of the coin, a historical figure, monument, place, symbol or event must be represented. It must also relate to either the person on the front, or to U.S. history in general. You may choose more than one object to put on this side of the coin.
