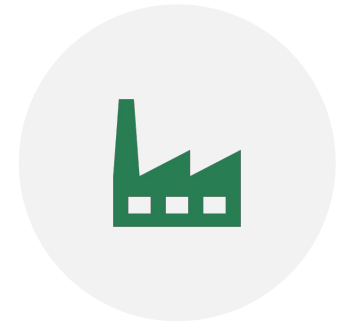

Phraseology (from **Greek** φράσις *phrasis*, "way of speaking" and -λογία *-logia*, "study of") is a scholarly approach to language which developed in the twentieth century

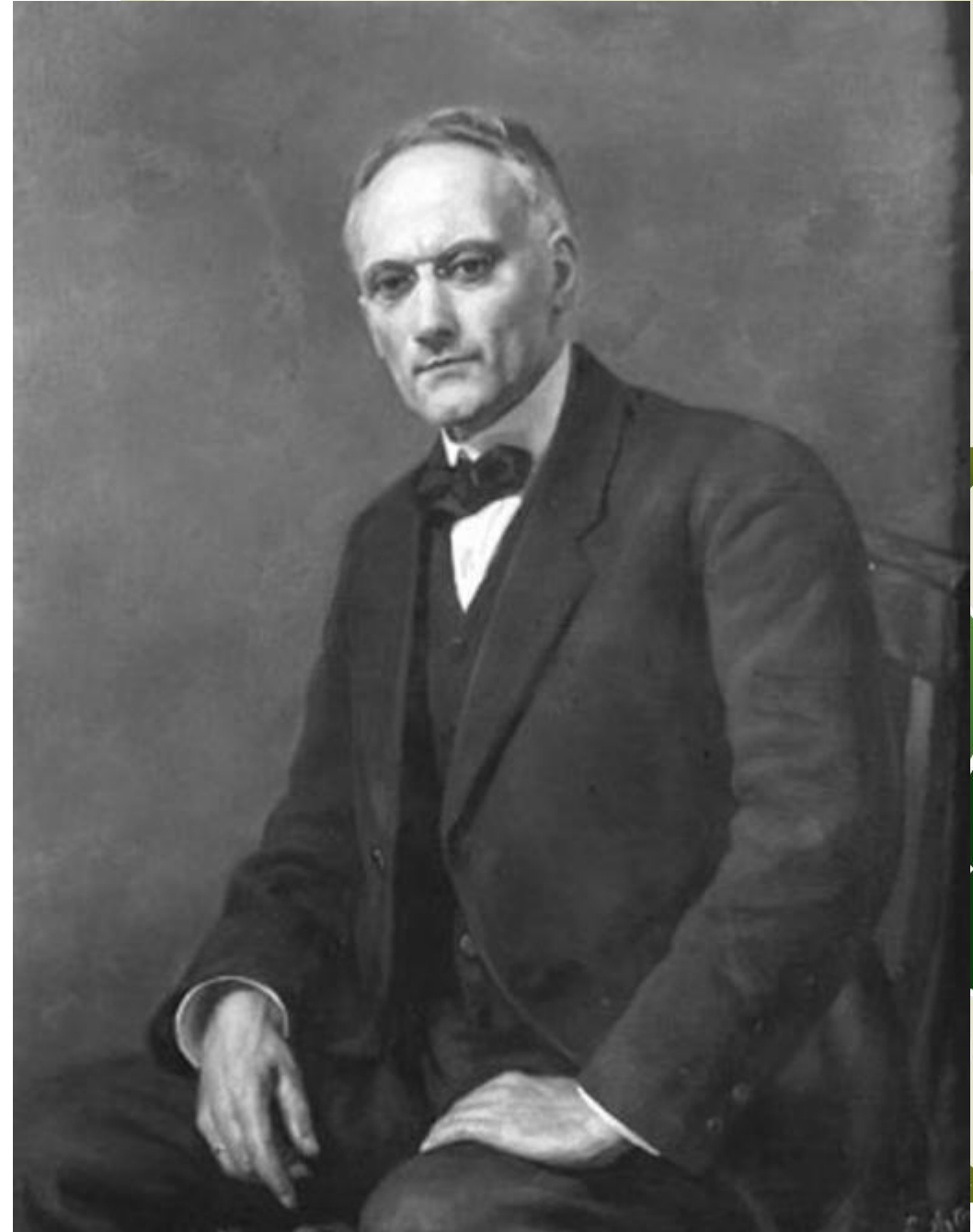

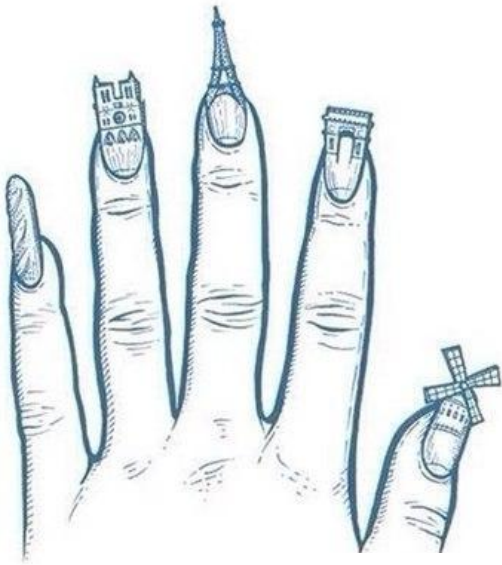
How and when did it appear?



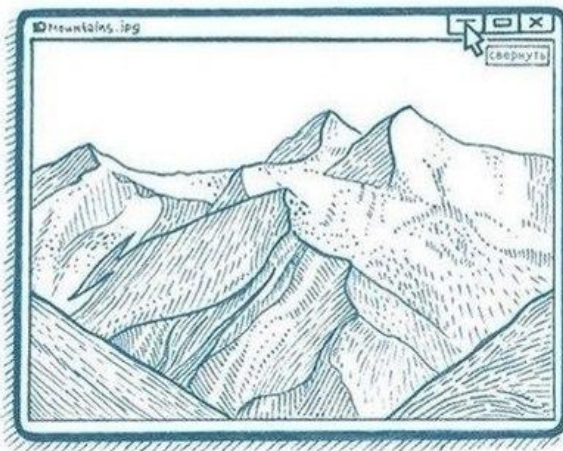
It took its start when Charles Bally's notion of *locutions phraseologiques* entered Russian lexicology and lexicography in the 1930s and 1940s and was subsequently developed in the former Soviet Union and other Eastern European countries.

Phraseological units:

White elephant – expensive, but useless thing

Дать сдачи – ответить ударом на удар

Түймедейді түйедей ету

Idioms:

Burn the midnight oil – to work late night

Не своей тарелке - о плохом самочувствии кого-н

Жүрек жалғап алайық - тамақтану

Free word-group

to take lessons – брать уроки

Different approaches to the classification of phraseological units: **semantic**, **functional**, **contextual**.

Approaches to the Study of Phraseological Units

semantic

Classifications of Phraseological Units

1. Classifications based on a **semantic approach**
 - semantic classification - according to the degree of motivation (V.V. Vinogradov)
 - structural classification – based on the ability to perform the same syntactical functions as words
 - structural-semantic classification by A.I. Smirnitsky
2. Classification based on a **functional approach**
 - structural-semantic classification (A.V. Koonin)
3. Classification based on a **contextual approach**
 - classification by N.N. Amosova

EXAMPLES:

Semantic

Once in a blue moon – very seldom;

To cry for the moon – to demand unreal;

Under the rose – quietly.

East or West, home is best - В гостях добре, а вдома краще

Marriages are made in heaven – Шлюби творяться на небесах

Contextual

not to lift a finger – не пошевелить пальцем

below the mark – ниже нормы

to take one's time – не торопиться

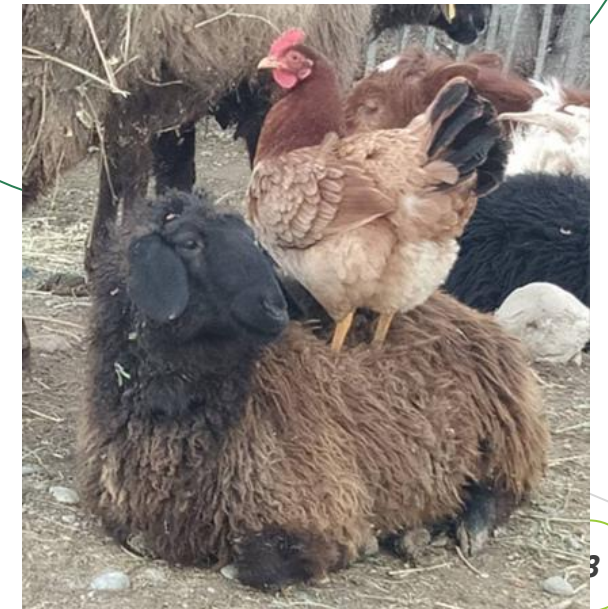
Functional

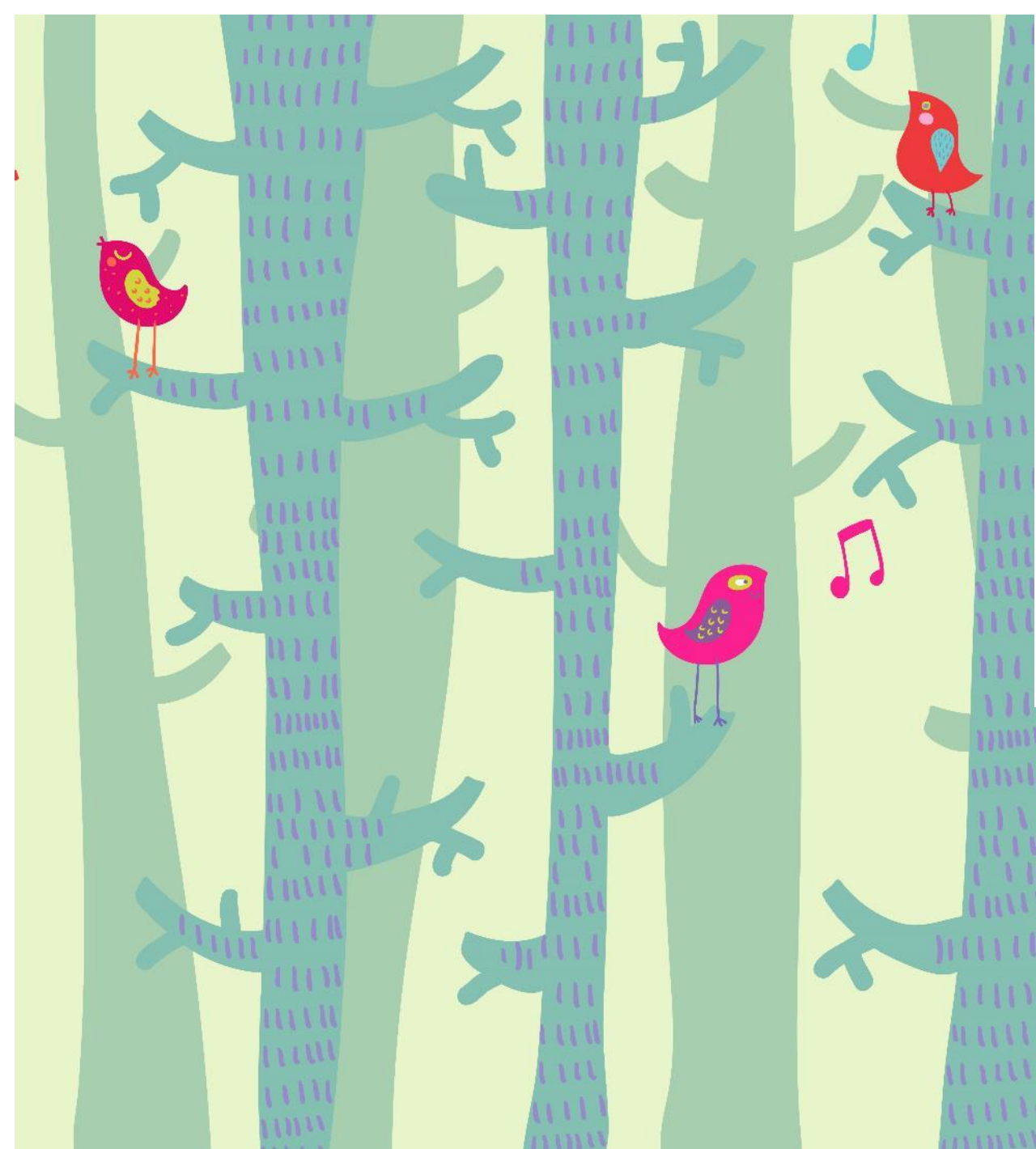
To back up – to support;

To drop out – to miss, to omit.

On the doorstep - quite near;

On the nose – exactly.





V.V. Vinogradovs Classification

phraseological combinations
(фразеологические сочетания) –
word-groups with partially changed

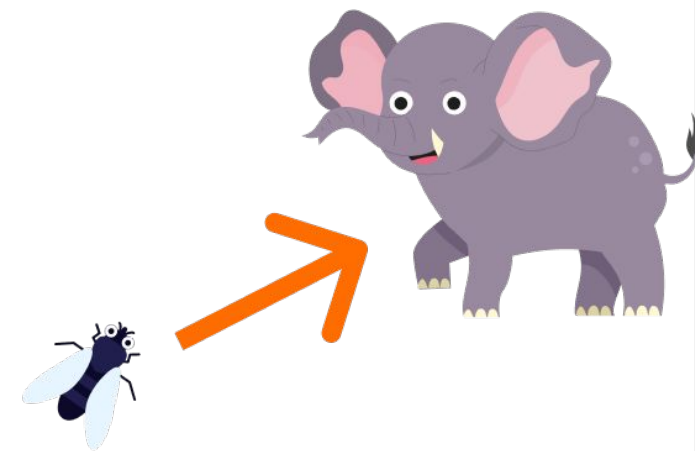
This classification is suitable only for phraseological units in structure equal to phrases.

In terms of its scope, this classification includes only phrases in the composition of the sentence and shows which members of the sentence they are, i.e. what syntactic function they perform.

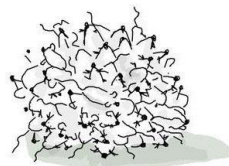
CONCLUSION

Using such combinations, we give our story **emotionality, aphoristic and even metaphorical.**



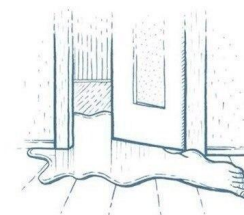
