Education



Educational system in Britain has strict quality standards. It is compulsory for all children aged 5 to 16 to study.

British education is divided into two segments: state schools, which are free of charge, and private schools, which are paid for.



Over 90% of children attend state public schools. Also Great Britain has two different systems of education: one is used in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and the other is used in Scotland.



The most popular schools in Britain are Boarding Schools. These are institutions where kids not only study, but live.
