Alternative guestion

(Альтернативный вопрос)

Альтернативный вопрос предлагает выбор между двумя возможностями.

Строится на основе общего вопроса и содержит союз "or" - «или». На альтернативный вопрос нельзя ответить «Да» или «Нет», нужно сделать выбор. Обычно даются полные ответы.

Did she finish writing the article <u>in the morning or at night</u>? Она закончила писать статью утром или вечером?

Did she finish writing <u>an article</u> or <u>a letter</u>? Она закончила писать статью или письмо ?

Did she finish <u>writing</u> or <u>reading</u> the article? Она закончила писать или читать статью?

1	Future Simple	Will Mary arrange a picnic for her friends tomorrow or next Saturday?

 - Is it a girl OR (Is It) a boy ?
 - ? The Disjunctive Question (разделительный вопрос)

Повествовательное предложение + Краткий вопрос общего типа

Nick is a nice boy, Isn't he ?

Nick does not play tennis, does he ?

Types of Fixed-Alternative Questions

- Simple-dichotomy (dichotomous) Question
 - Requires the respondent to choose one of two alternatives (e.g., yes or no).
- Determinant-choice Question
 - Requires the respondent to choose one response from among multiple alternatives (e.g., A, B, or C).
- Frequency-determination Question
 - Asks for an answer about general frequency of occurrence (e.g., often, occasionally, or never).
- Checklist Question
 - Allows the respondent to provide multiple answers to a single question by checking off items.



Can he drive or can he ride a bike?



He can ride a bike.



Is the house big or is the house small?



The house is big.



Is she a teacher or is she a doctor?



She is a teacher.



Are they in London or are they in Angarsk?



They are in London.



Is it a box or is it a bag?



It is a box.



Can the duck ski or can the duck cook?



The duck can ski.
