PASSIVE VOICE

The passive voice is used in English when it is more convenient or interesting to stress the thing done than the doer of it, or when the doer is unknown:

My bag was stolen is much more usual than **Thieves stole my bag.**

- * The passive of an active tense is formed by putting the verb TO BE into the same tense as the active verb and adding the past participle of the active verb:

Active: He **wrote** a letter.
Passive: A letter **was written**.

In a passive sentence the agent, or doer of the action, is very often not mentioned. When the agent is mentioned it is preceded by **BY**:

Active: My brother has written that poem.
Passive: That poem has been written **by my brother**.

Table of active and their passive equivalents

TENSE	ACTIVE VOICE	PASSIVE VOICE
Simple Present	writes	is written
Present Continuous	is writing	is being written
Simple Past	wrote	was written
Past Continuous	was writing	was being written
Present Perfect	has written	has been written
Past Perfect	had written	had been written
Future	will write	will be written
Conditional	would write	would be written
Present Infinitive	to write	to be written
Perfect Infinitive	to have written	to have been written
Present Participle	writing	being written
Perfect Participle	having written	having been written
