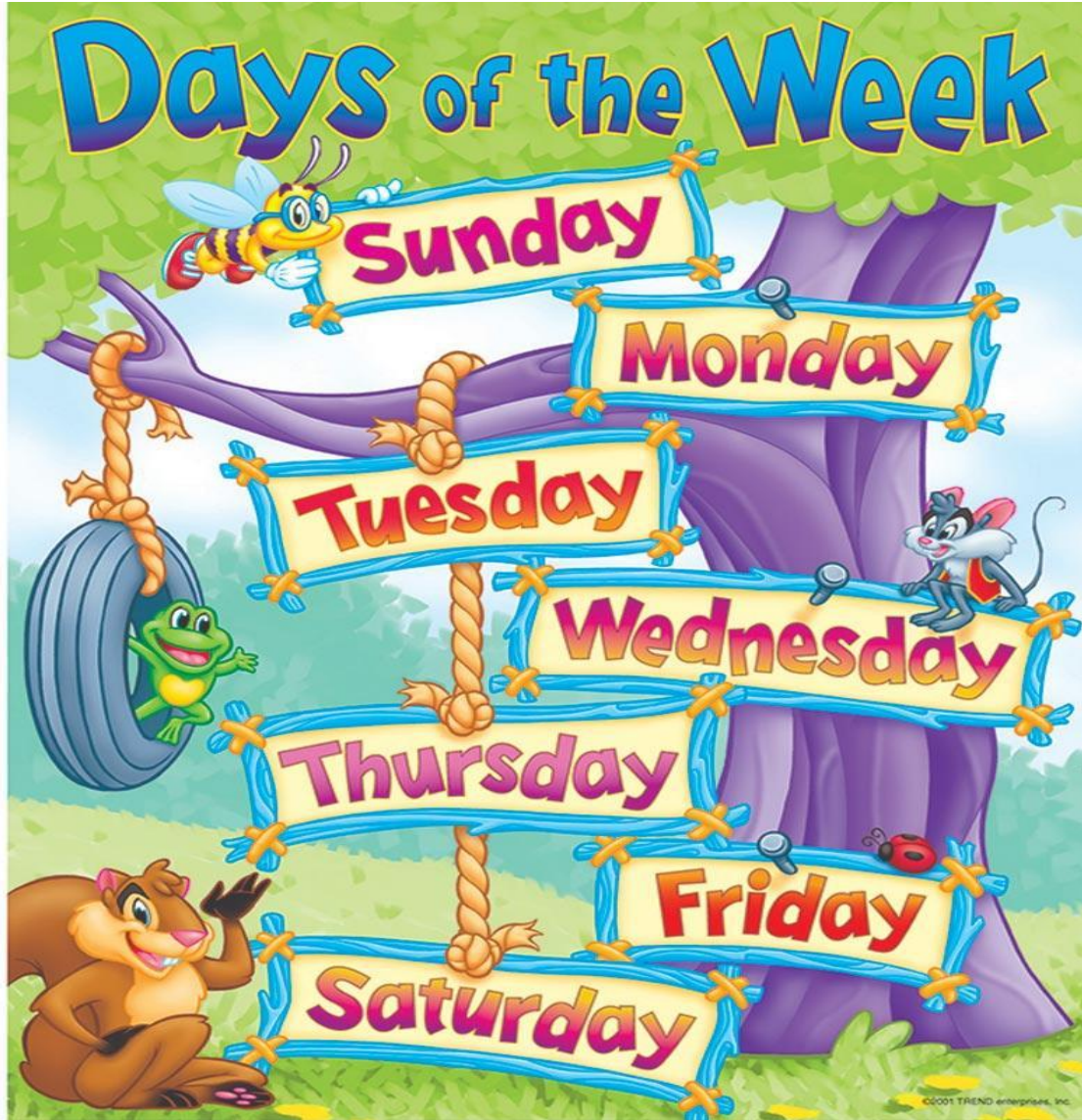

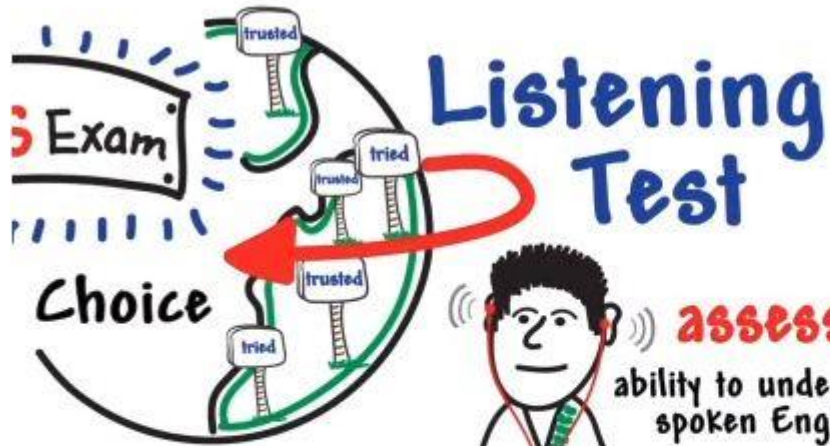



Ее называют немой гласной:

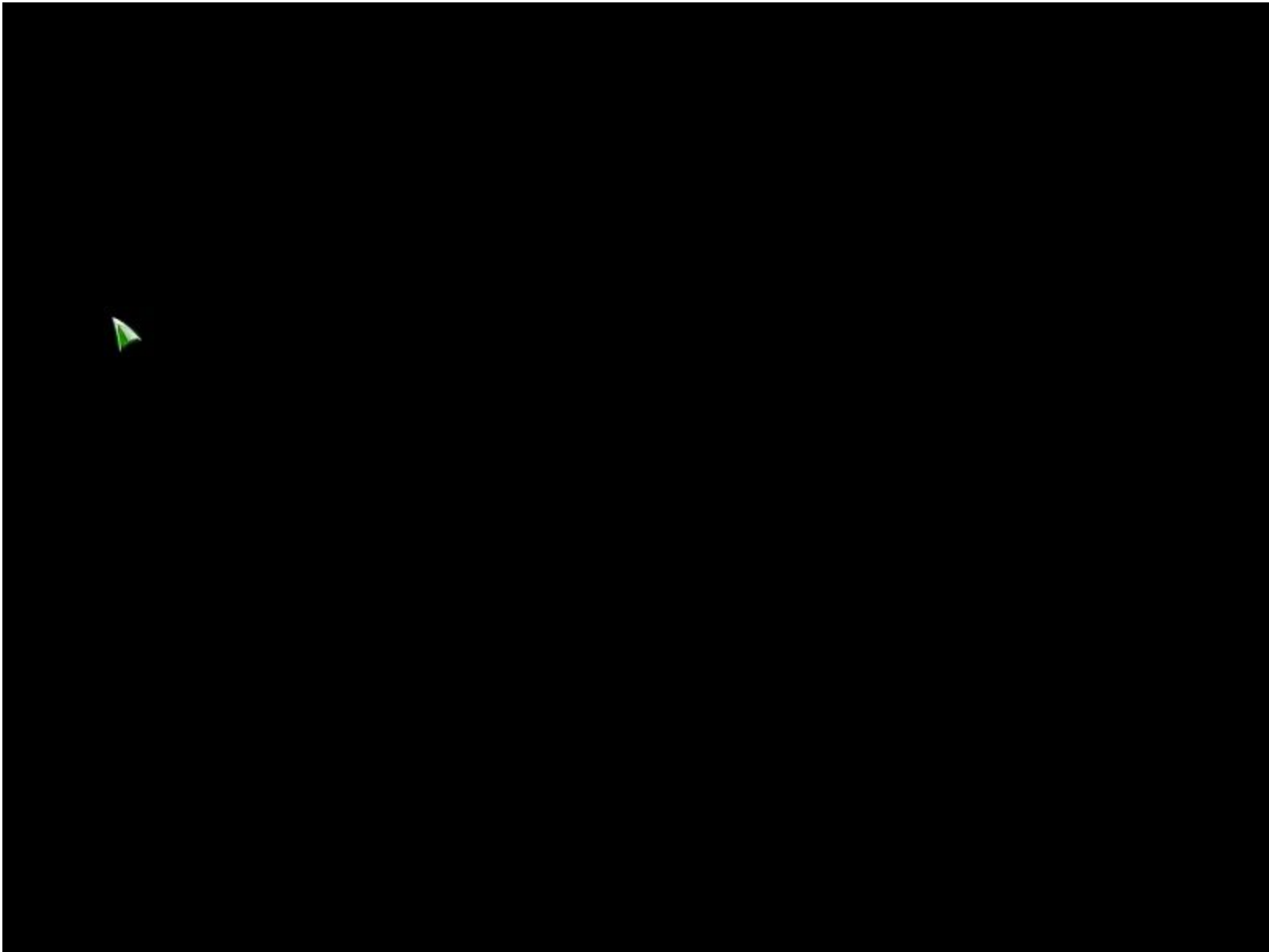
