GRAMMAR - PRESENT CONTINUOUS

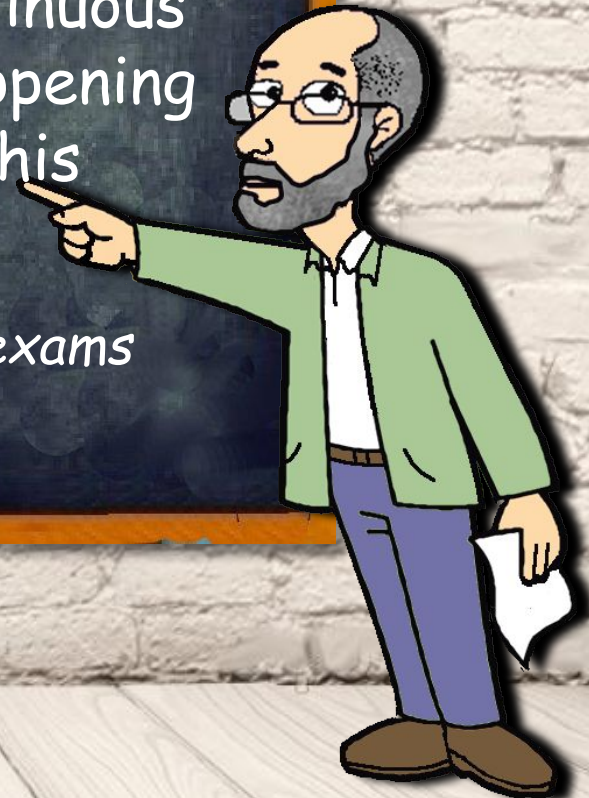
USE

We use the Present Continuous Tense to talk about activities happening now.

Example: *She is playing chess at the moment.*

We can also use the Present Continuous Tense to talk about activities happening around now, and not necessarily this very moment.

Example: *He is studying hard for his exams this week.*

GRAMMAR - PRESENT CONTINUOUS

AFFIRMATIVE

He **is** skating

They **are** swimming

She **is** running



*

GRAMMAR - PRESENT CONTINUOUS

NEGATIVE

I'm not /ing
You aren't /ing
He isn't /ing
She isn't /ing
It isn't /ing
We aren't /ing
You aren't /ing
They aren't /ing

INTERROGATIVE

QUESTIONS

Am I playing ?

Are you playing ?

Is he playing ?

Is she playing ?

Is it playing ?

Are we playing ?

Are you playing ?

Are they playing ?

SHORT ANSWERS

Yes, I am/you are

No, I'm not/you aren't

Yes, he/she/it is

No, he/she/it isn't

Yes, we/you/they are

No, we/you/they aren't
