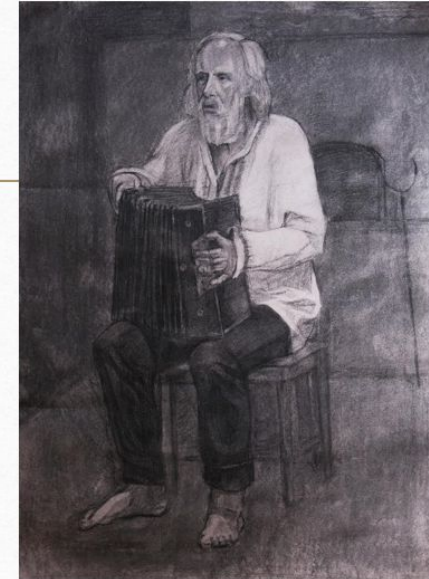

Then wait what the employer will ask

If employer like your personal profile, you will be invited for job interview.

It's important to prepare for it, some tips for successful interview:

Five positive tips for job interview:

1. Compliance of the dress code is very important.
2. Applicant for vacancy should speak competently!
3. Applicant should be polite with people around him or her.
4. It's very significantly to be self-confident.
5. Use information which is connected with vacancy

Five negative tips job interview:

1. Lateness without a respectful reason is the best way to get a rejection!
2. If you don't want to get the job – speak a lot about everything, don't give an opportunity to speak for employer!
3. It will be very strange, if you know anything about company and vacancy, but you can try.
4. Use your cell phone, when employer talk to you, it's your guarantee to be unemployed.
5. Tell fairy tales if this job is not important to you.
