
Simon is having his temperature taken.

Simon is getting his Mum to take his temperature.


She is painting her portrait.

He will repair the TV set.

He will have the TV set repaired. He will get the TV set repaired.

He is having a technician repair the TV set.

He is getting a technician to repair the TV set.





She had dried her hair.

She had had her hair dried.

She had got her hair dried.

She had had the hairdresser

dry her hair.

She had got the hairdresser

to dry her hair.



He was measuring his blood pressure.

He was having his blood pressure measured.

He was getting his blood pressure measured.

He was having a doctor measure

his pressure.

He was getting a doctor to measure his pressure.



## The optician tested her eyes.

- She had her eyes tested (by the optician).
- She got her eyes tested (by the optician).
- She had the optician test her eyes.
- She got the optician to test her eyes.



## The mechanic repairs his car.

- He has his car repaired (by the mechanic).
- He gets his car repaired (by the mechanic).
- He has the mechanic repair his car.
- He gets the mechanic to repair his car.
