# History of adoption:

- **NATIONAL EMBLEM**

- National emblem consist of a shield that is red colored with white sinister in its mid. In its center the cedar tree is present same as referring to country's national flag. With a minor variation that the horizontal stripes of colors are transformed into a bend sinister. And the meanings of different colors of stripes and the cedar are same , which are represented by them in national flag
