Died:27 March 1968 (34 years old), near the village of Novoselovo Vladimir region, RSFSR, USSR


October 27, 1955, Gagarin was drafted into the army and sent to





April 8, 1961 the State Commission for the launch of the spacecraft "Vostok argues Yuri Gagarin on the first flight into space.

On 12 April 1961 took place the first flight into space on the ship-satellite "Vostok" with Yuri Gagarin on Board. The stay in space was 108 minutes.



Space flight over. "Happened, as in a good novel: my return from space occurred in those very places where the first time I flew on airplanes" (Yuri Gagarin "Road to space").

In September 1964 he began work on the proposals on space debris, as there was a need for agreement on principles governing the activities of States in the exploration and use of outer space, including the moon and other celestial bodies. He initiated the creation of a whole code space, with proposals for agreement on the rescue of astronaut, on liability for damage caused by space objects, etc.

Day April 12, 1961, humanity will not be forgotten, and the name of the senior Lieutenant Yuri Gagarin forever inscribed in the history of mankind and will be one of the most famous in the world.
