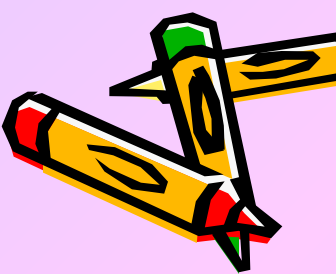
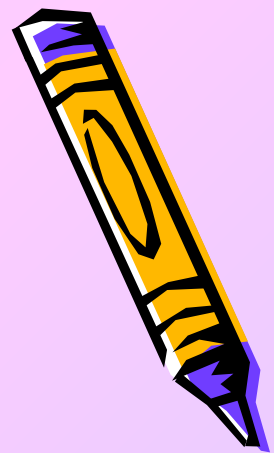


"The British Museum".

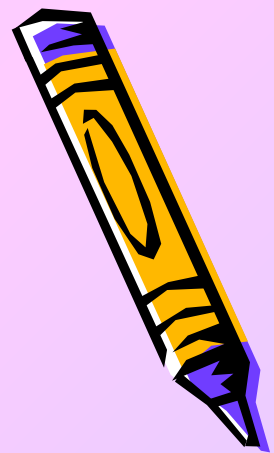
Are OK, Robin? We are near a big museum. I see the light in the windows. Let us go in. It is cold here. We can not sleep in the park.

They have the best collection of dinosaurs in the world!





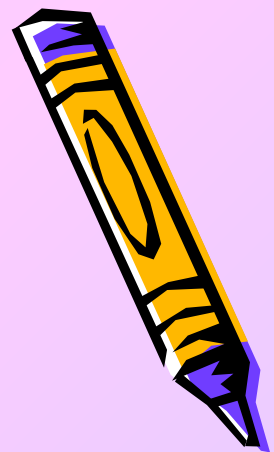

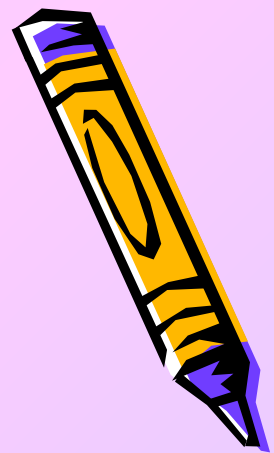
