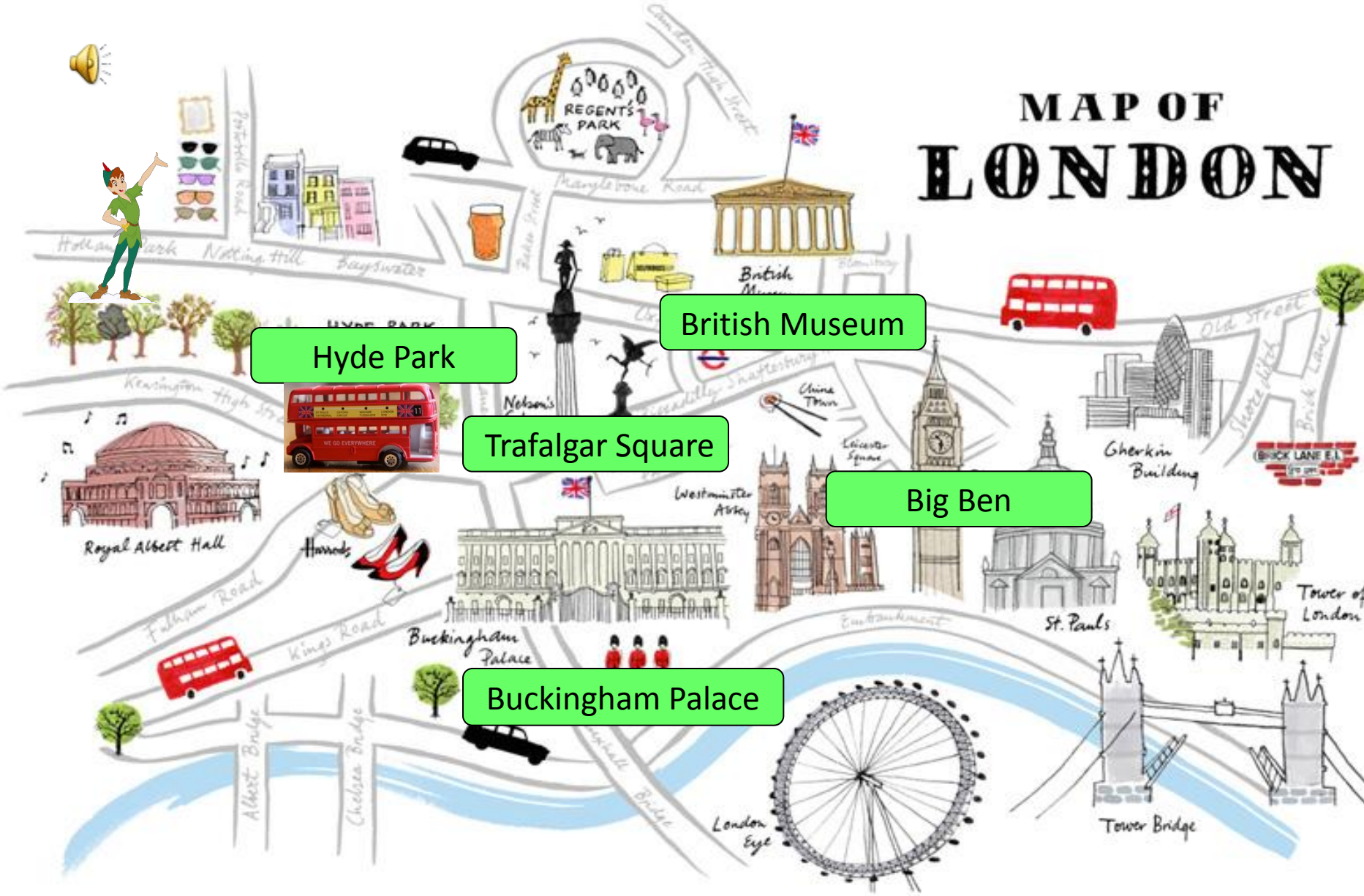

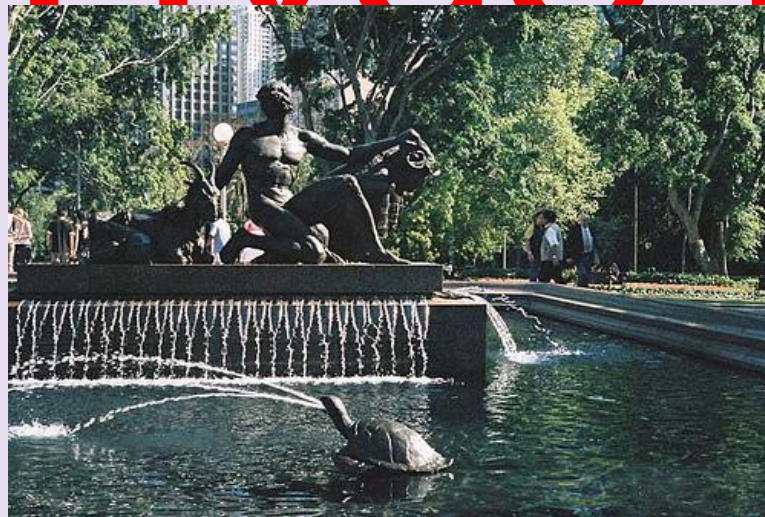


A famous building which contains a large and important collection of ancient art, writings, coins, drawings.
