CANADA IS KNOWN AS THE HOMELAND OF HOCKEY.

MARCH 3, 1875 IN MONTREAL AT THE RINK "VICTORIA" WAS HELD THE FIRST HOCKEY MATCH. EACH OF THE TEAMS CONSISTED OF NINE PEOPLE. THEY PLAYED WITH A WOODEN PUCK. FOR THE FIRST TIME, A HOCKEY GOAL WAS PUT ON ICE.



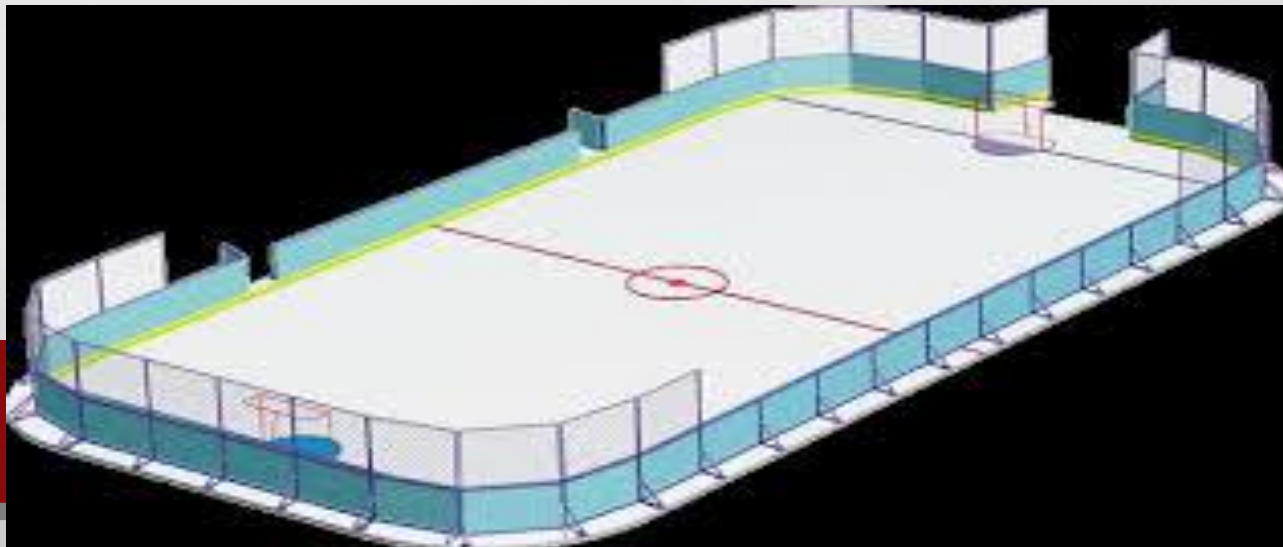
NEW AMATEUR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION

- **IN 1877, SEVERAL STUDENTS INVENTED THE FIRST SEVEN HOCKEY RULES, AND IN 1897 MADE A RUBBER PUCK. IN 1885, THE AMATEUR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION WAS FOUNDED IN MONTREAL.**



HOCKEY COURT

CURRENTLY, ACCORDING TO THE RULES OF HOCKEY, THE COURT SHOULD BE PREFERABLY 60X30 METERS IN SIZE, THE CORNERS OF THE COURT SHOULD BE ROUNDED BY AN ARC. THE PLATFORM SHOULD BE SURROUNDED BY PLASTIC SIDES WITH A HEIGHT OF NOT LESS THAN 1 METER. PROTECTIVE GLASS SHOULD BE INSTALLED ON THE FRONT SIDES OF THE PLATFORM AND A PROTECTIVE NET TO PREVENT THE WASHER FROM FLYING OVER THE GLASS.



HOCKEY GOAL

HOCKEY GATES ARE MOUNTED ON PINS FOR WHICH HOLES ARE DRILLED IN ICE. GOAL CONSTRUCTION: WIDTH - 1.83 METERS, HEIGHT - 1.22 METERS. THE GOAL AREA IS USUALLY DRAWN FROM THE CENTER OF THE GOAL LINE



HOCKEY EQUIPMENT

MUCH ATTENTION IS PAID TO HOCKEY EQUIPMENT. ATHLETES TAKE CARE TO PROTECT THEMSELVES FROM BLOWS AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE. THE TOP UNIFORM AND HELMETS OF THE TEAM PLAYERS MUST BE THE SAME COLOR. PLAYERS' SWEATERS MUST BEAR NUMBERS AND SURNAMENES.



HOCKEY HALL OF FAME

- **CANADA IS CONSIDERED A HOCKEY COUNTRY FOR A REASON. IT IS DIFFICULT TO NAME A NATION THAT IS MORE WORRIED ABOUT ITS HOCKEY TEAM THAN CANADIANS. THEREFORE, A HOCKEY HALL OF FAME WAS OPENED IN TORONTO. THE MUSEUM CONTAINS ACHIEVEMENTS OF BOTH CANADIAN AND EUROPEAN PLAYERS. THERE IS A DEPARTMENT FOR AMERICANS AND OTHER COUNTRIES WHO ALSO LOVE HOCKEY**
