It is interesting that the London Eye had a predecessor. July 17, 1895 was the opening of the Great Wheel (Great Wheel), built by George Washington Goossens with the Chicago Ferris Wheel (Chicago Ferris Wheel) and served until 1907. It reached 94 feet tall and had a 40 specially designed cabins, each of which could accommodate up to 40 people.
