- 5) Unfortunately, not all animals can be saved. Therefore, cold endurance and nerves of steel are a mandatory factor in the profession of a veterinarian. For particularly sensitive people, this profession can negatively affect their overall emotional well-being.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PROFESSION

- 1) Sufficient knowledge to help different animals.
- 2) You need a great love for animals, because without this you can not enjoy the profession.
- 3) Have patience, because animals cannot, as a person, explain what hurts them, tell about the symptoms of the disease and assume that they have a disease
- 4) Have composure and fortitude, because you will have to work with various animals, diseases, injuries, which are very unpleasant and can cause squeamishness.
