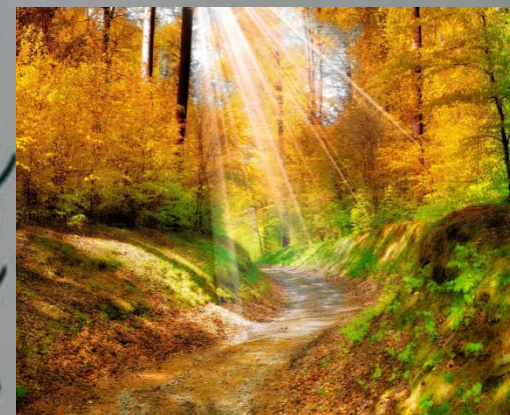

- ▶ **Verbs of possession.**

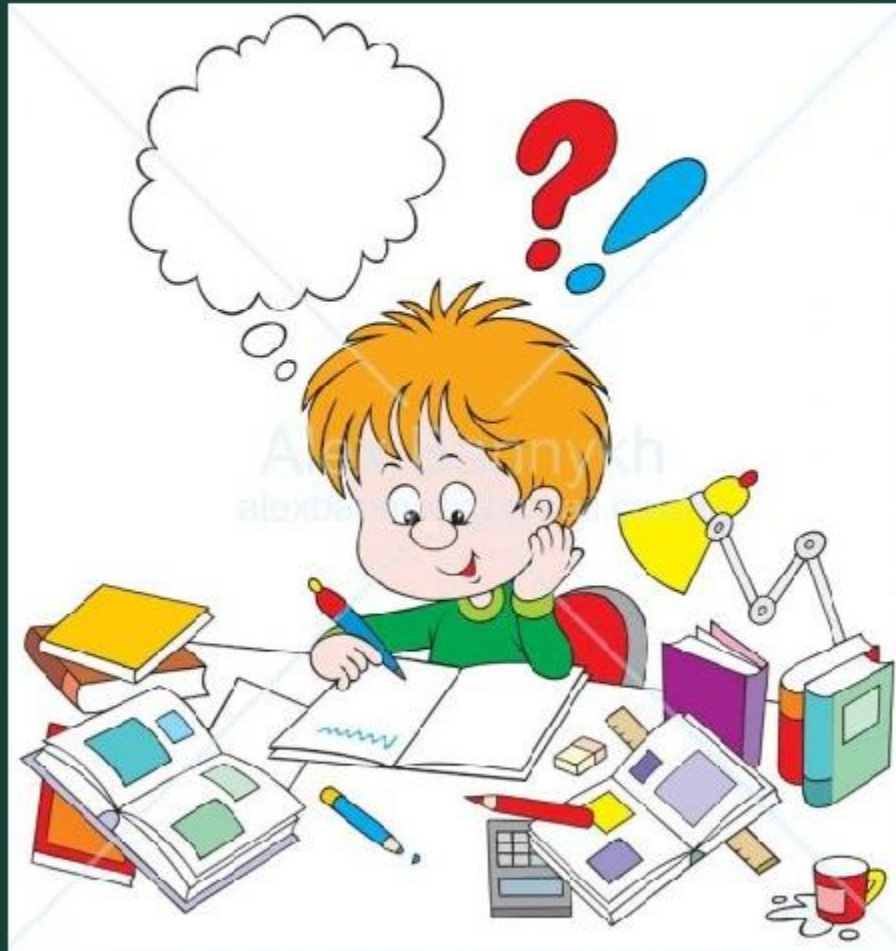
