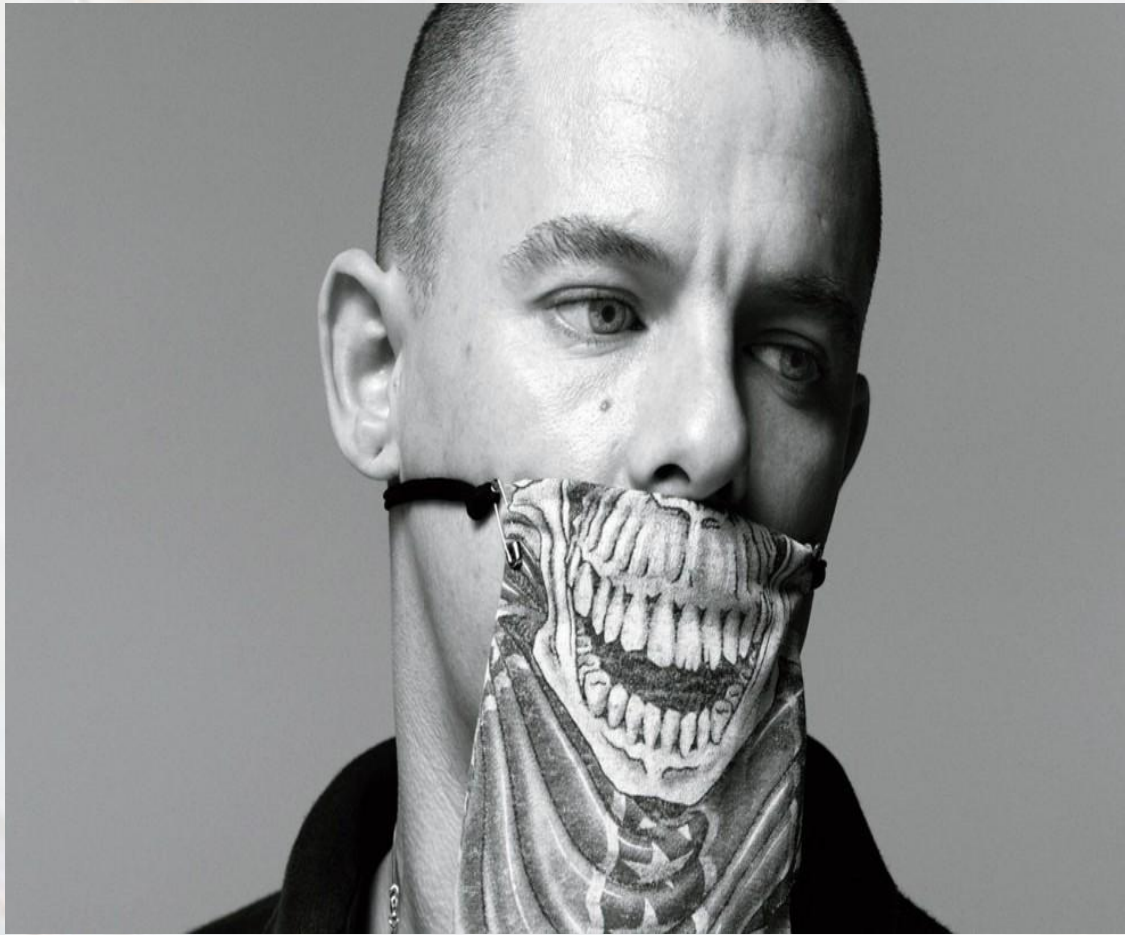

Key elements of McQueen's aesthetic include: roman, gothic, victorian-inspired pieces, like dark colors, thick fabrics, and red lace, animal-inspired textiles, especially animal skins, as well as frequent use of bird motifs, pieces inspired by military uniforms, traditional japanese
