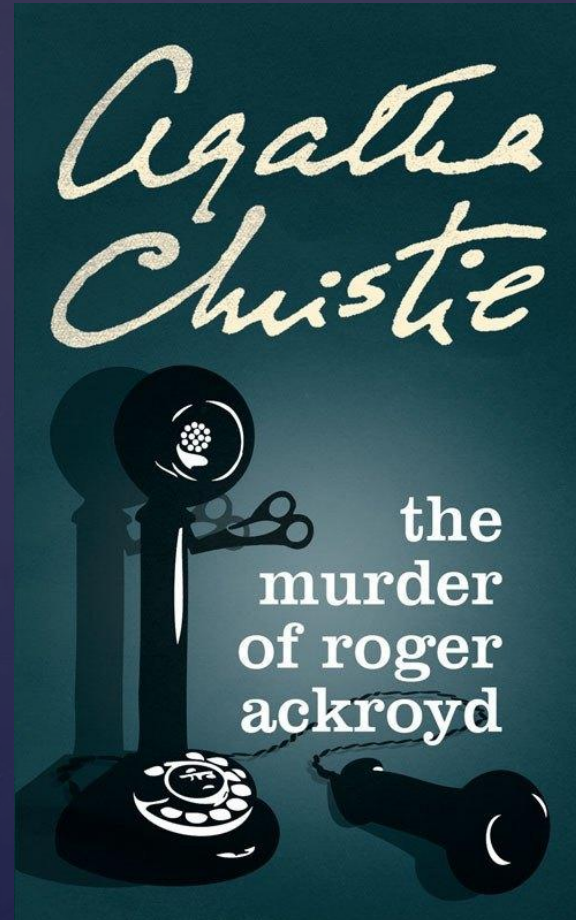
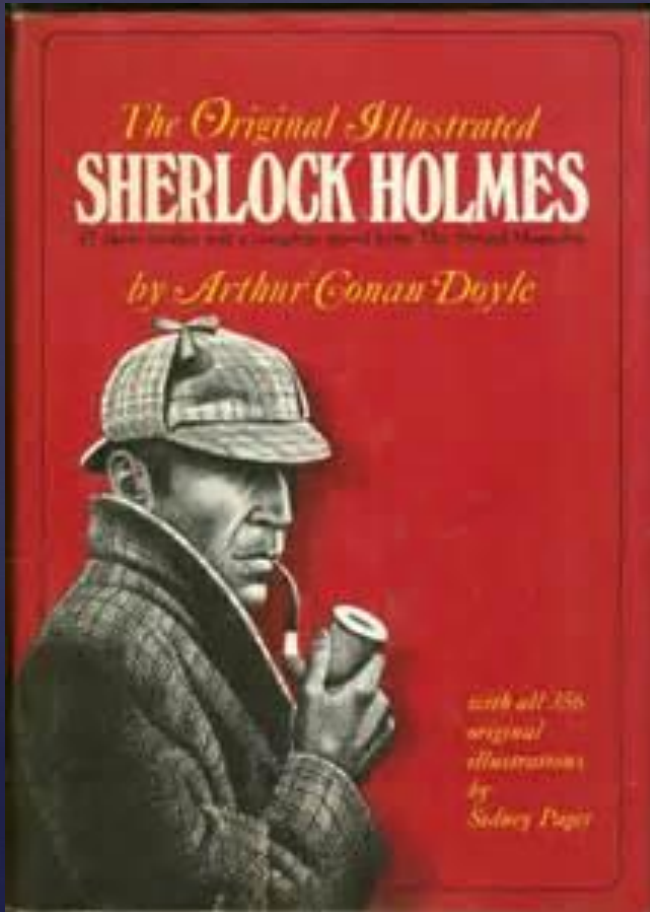
NOVEL

a story



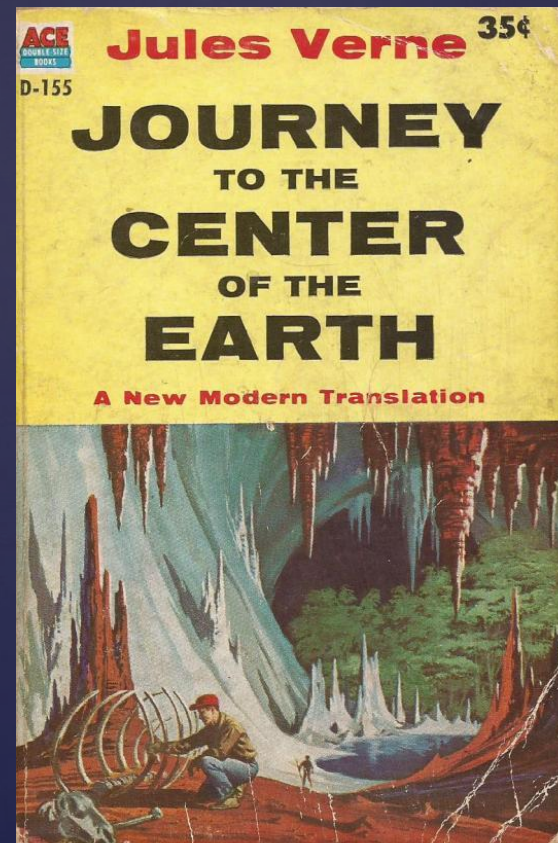
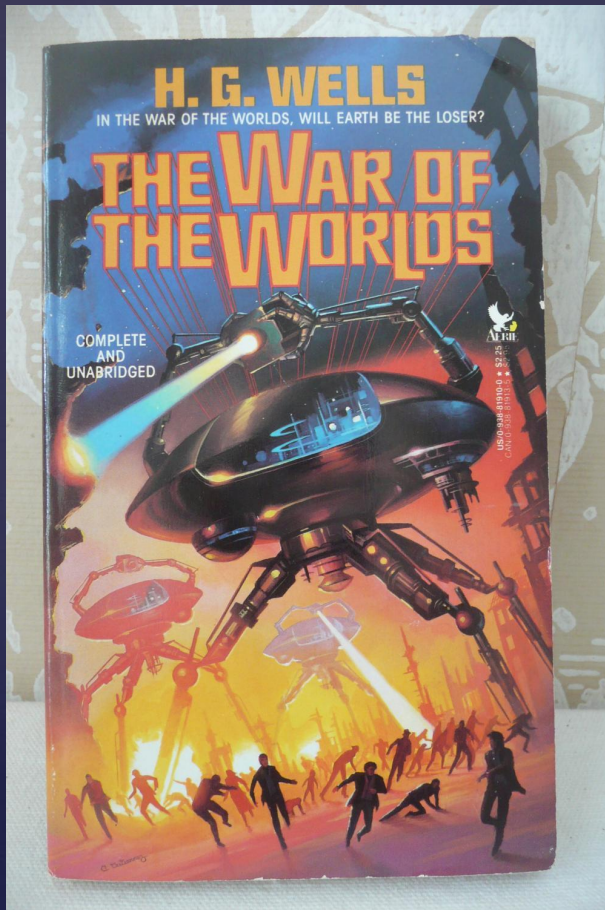
MYSTERY NOVEL/DETECTIVE STORIES

A story where the reader has to solve a puzzle



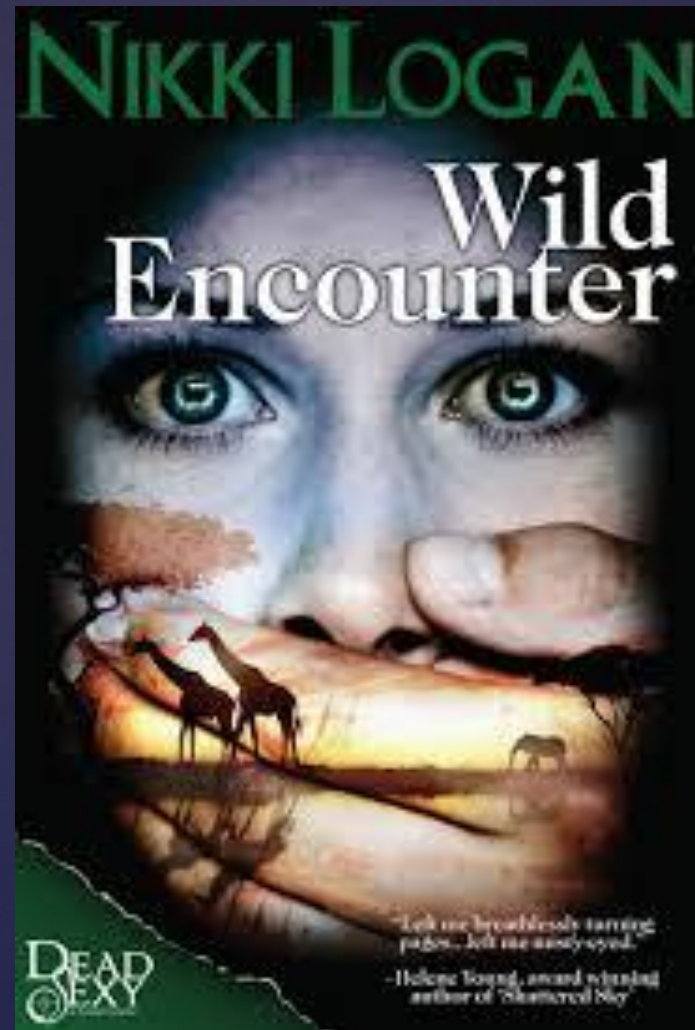
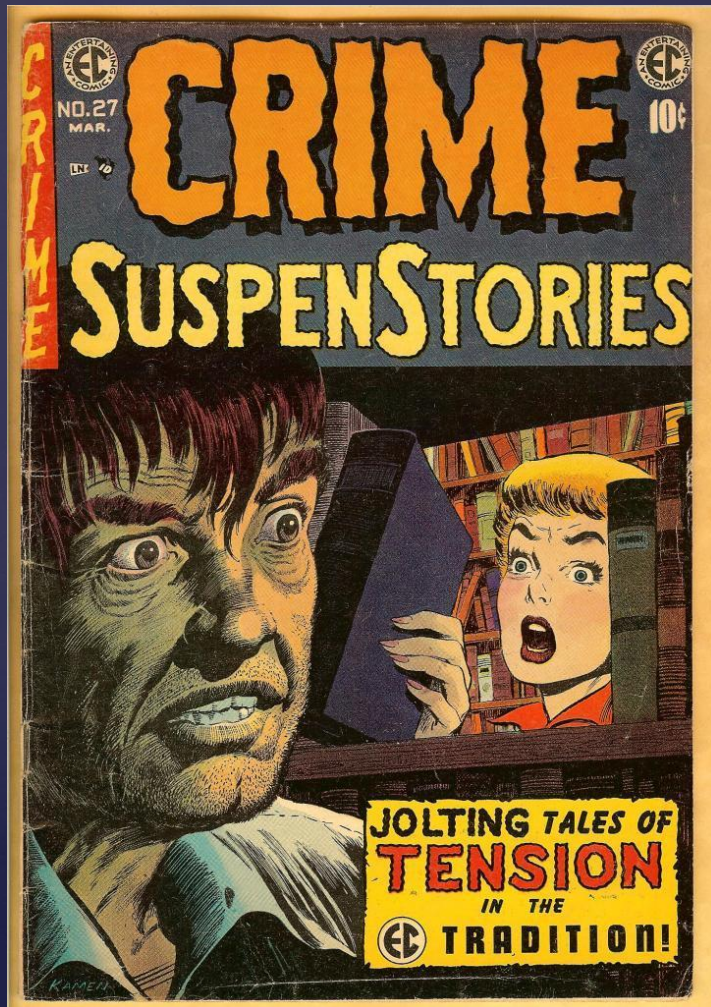
SCIENCE-FICTION NOVEL

space travel or time travel



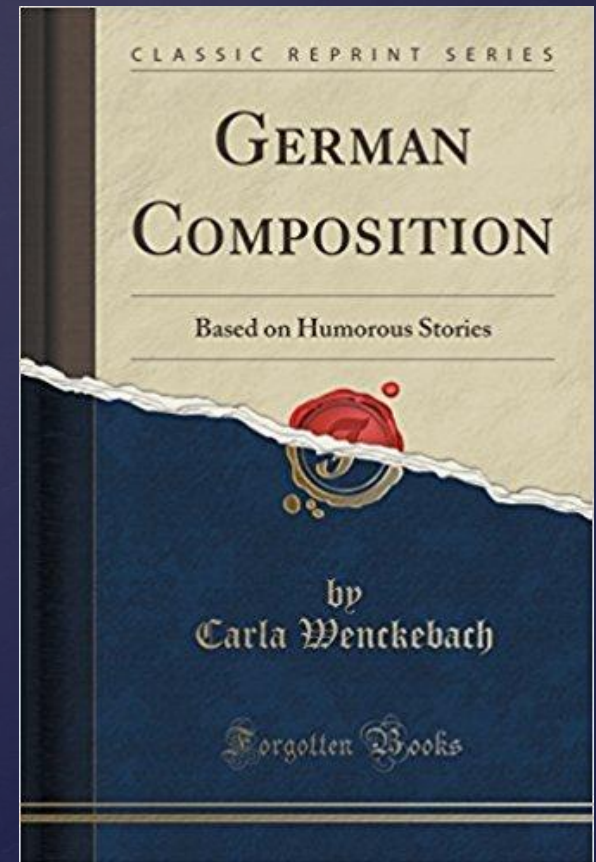
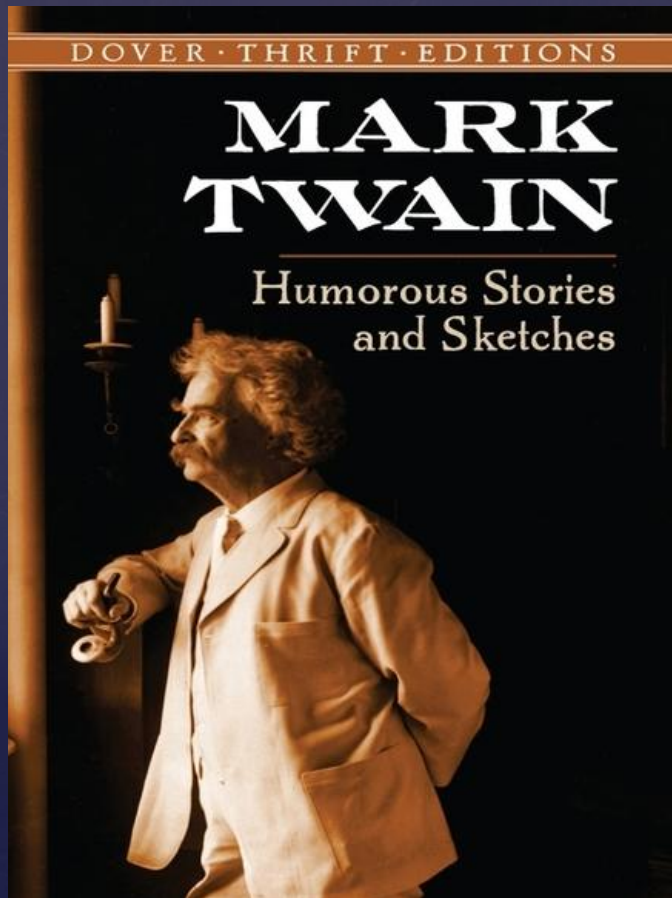
THRILLER/SUSPENSE

horror stories about crime, murder



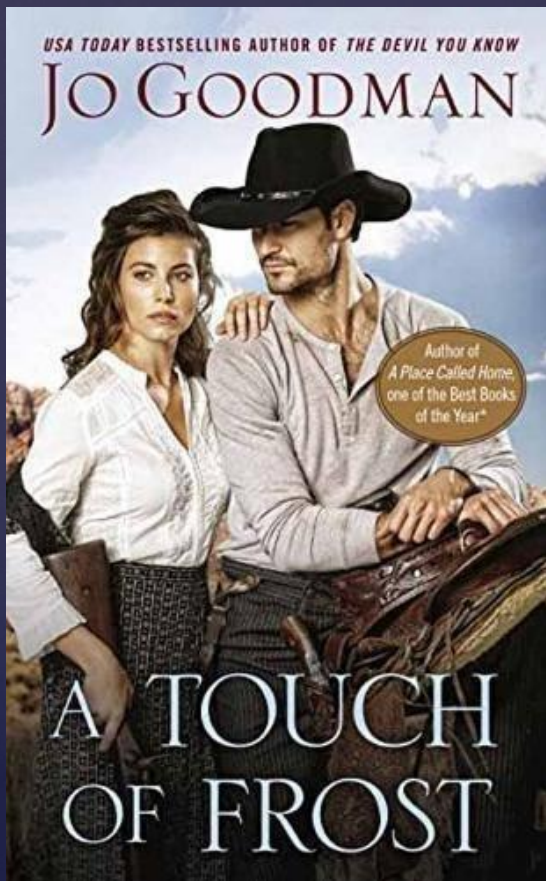
HUMOUROUS STORY

A funny story with a happy ending



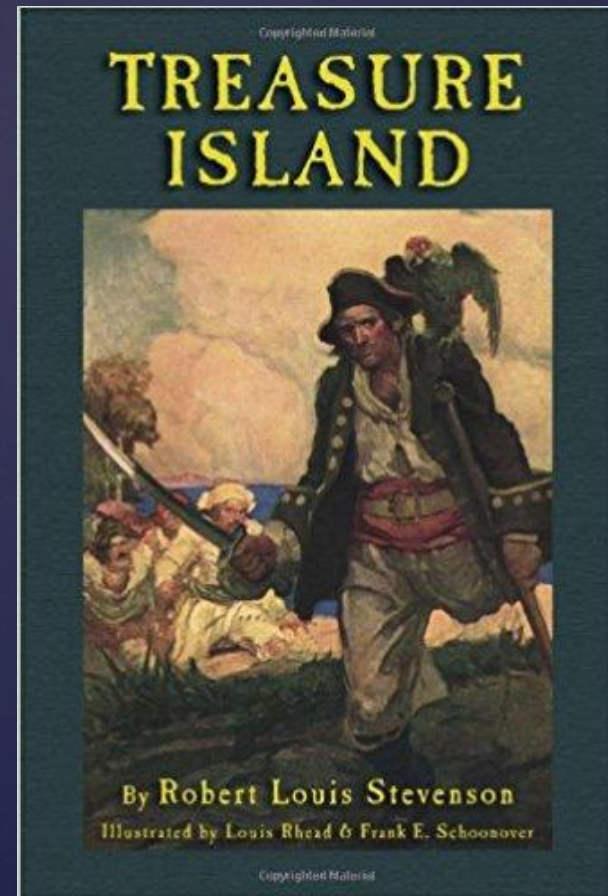
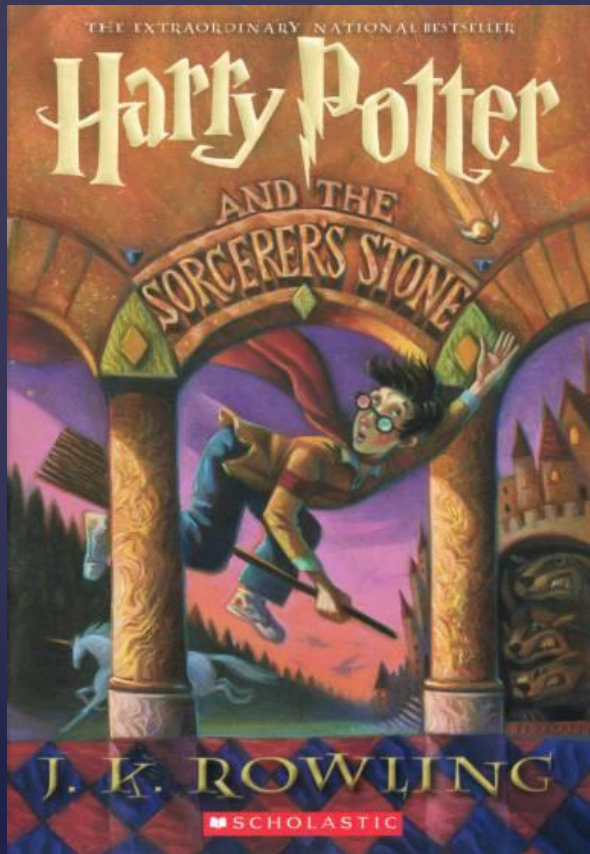

and relationship



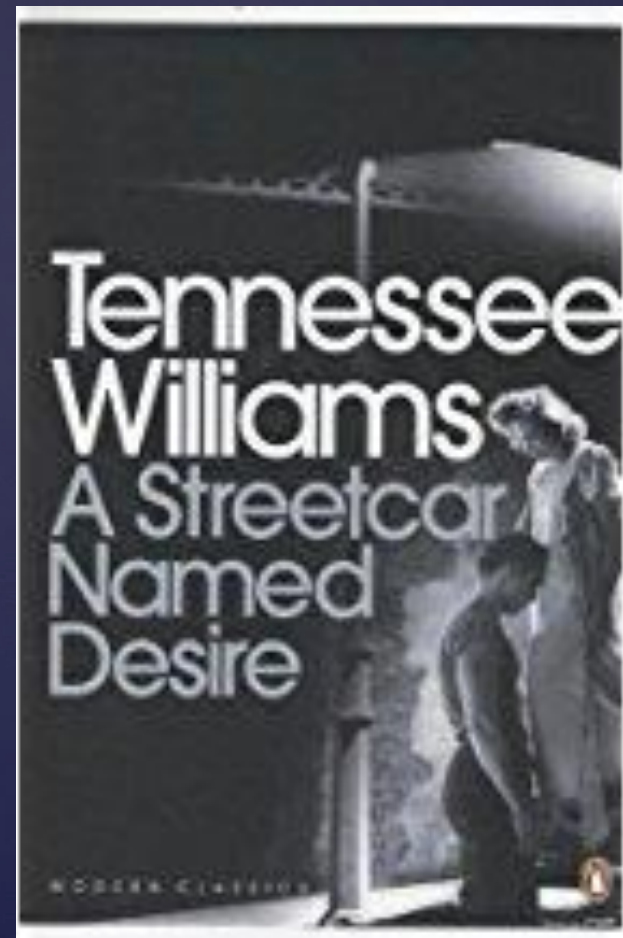
ADVENTURE STORY

A story about an exciting journey of the main character



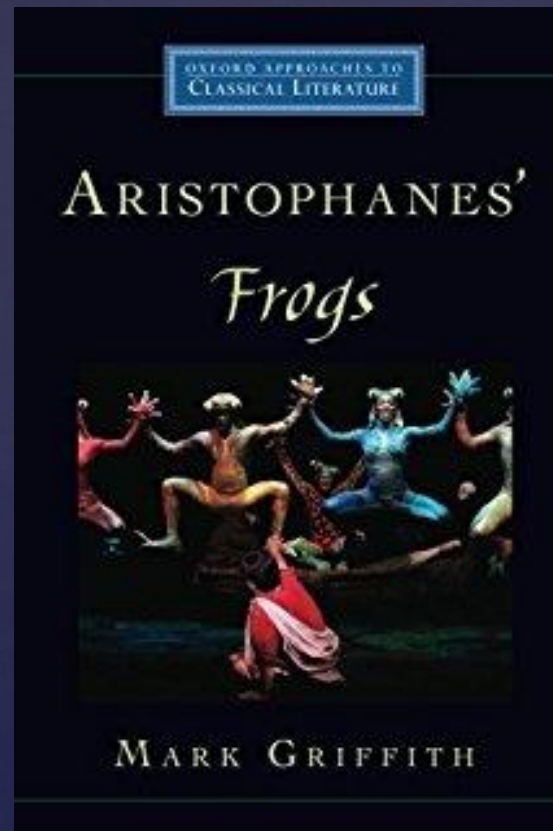
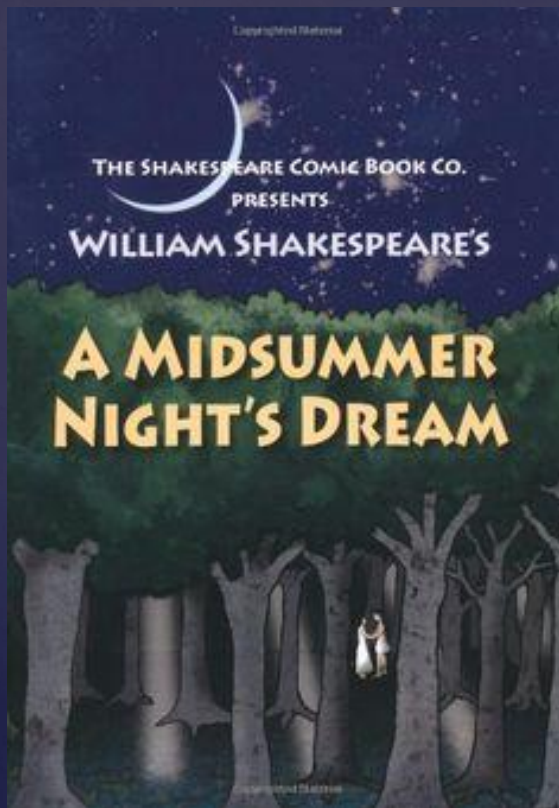

A funny and humorous play for theatres or TV



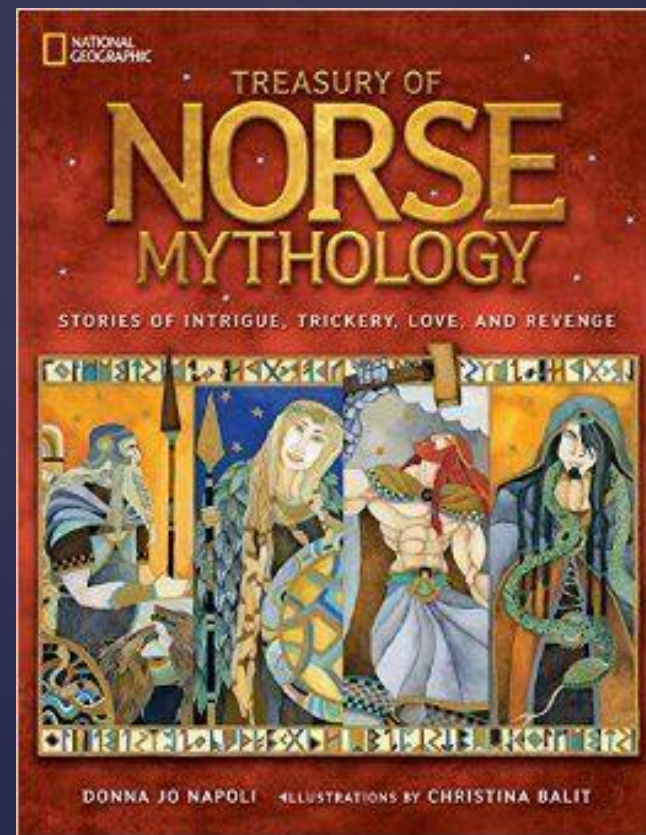
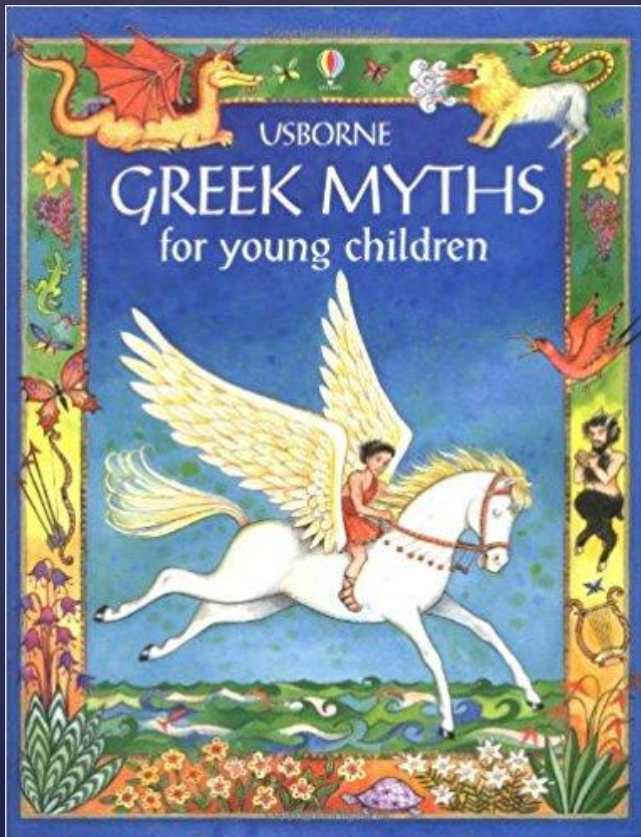

A story about fantastic events and magic creatures



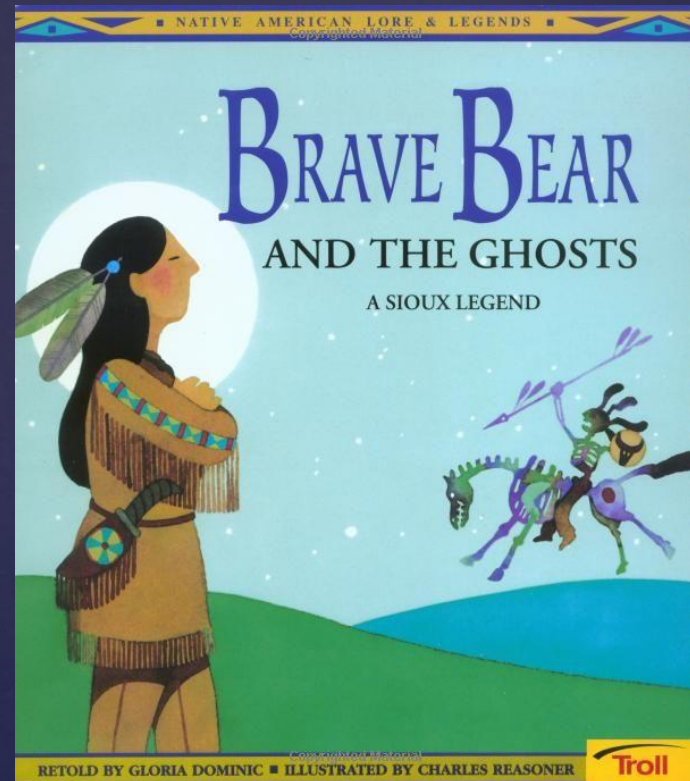
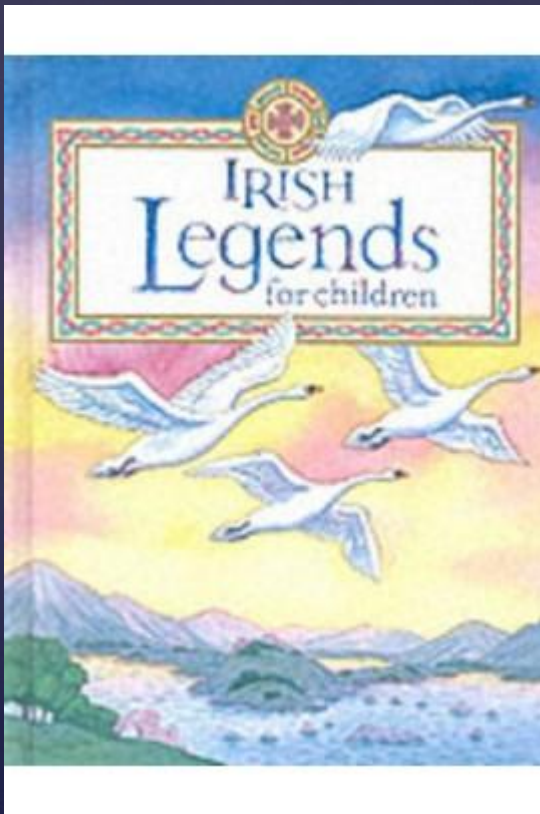

A traditional story about heroes of the past



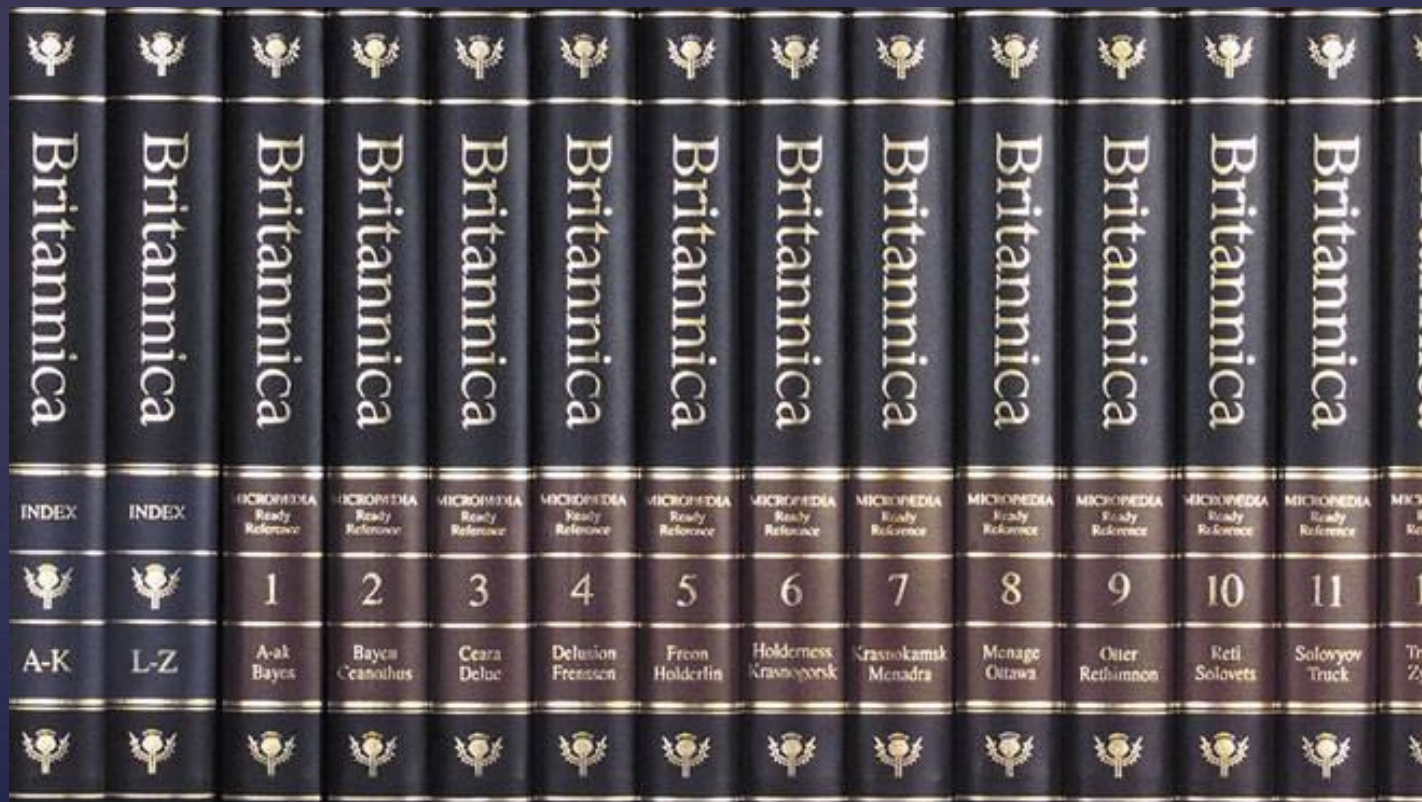

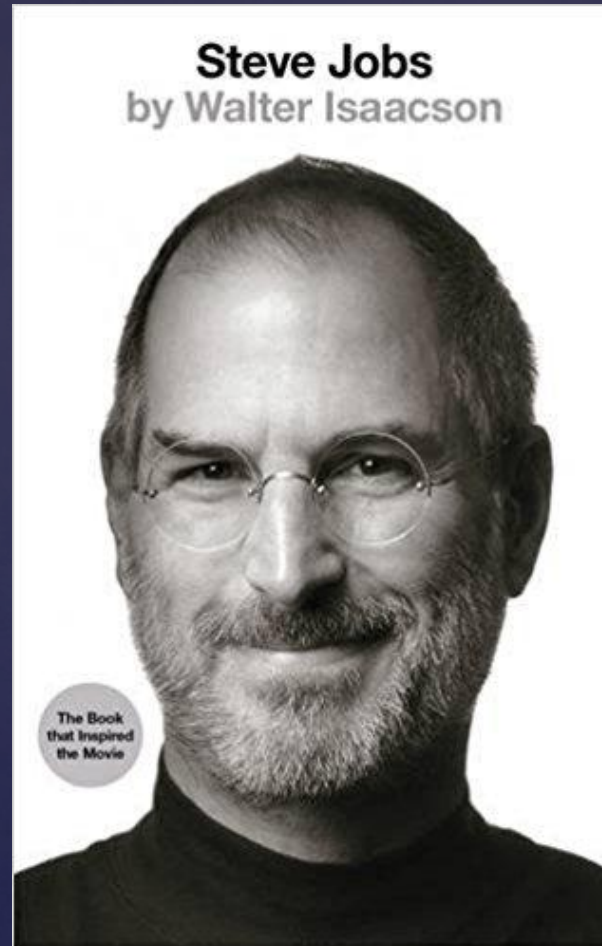
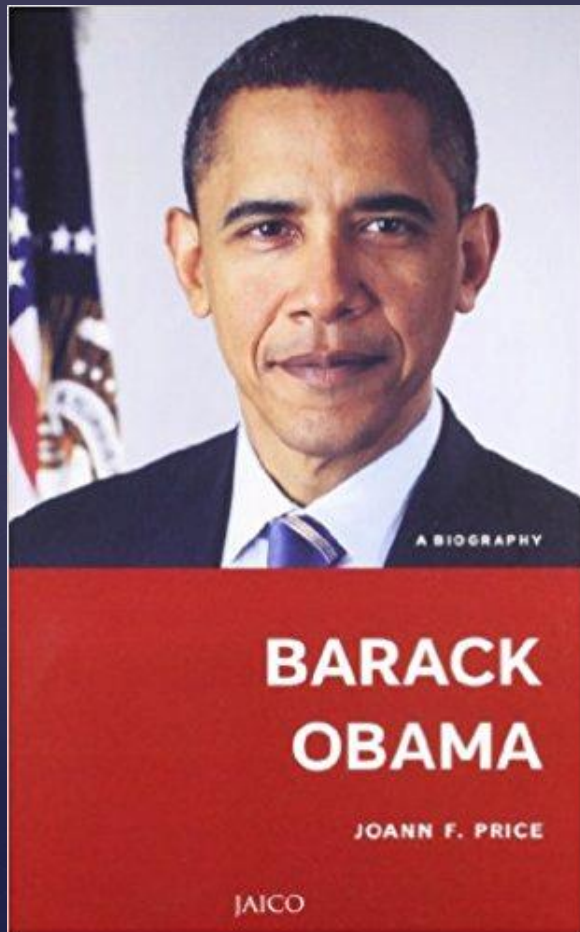

a reference book of knowledge



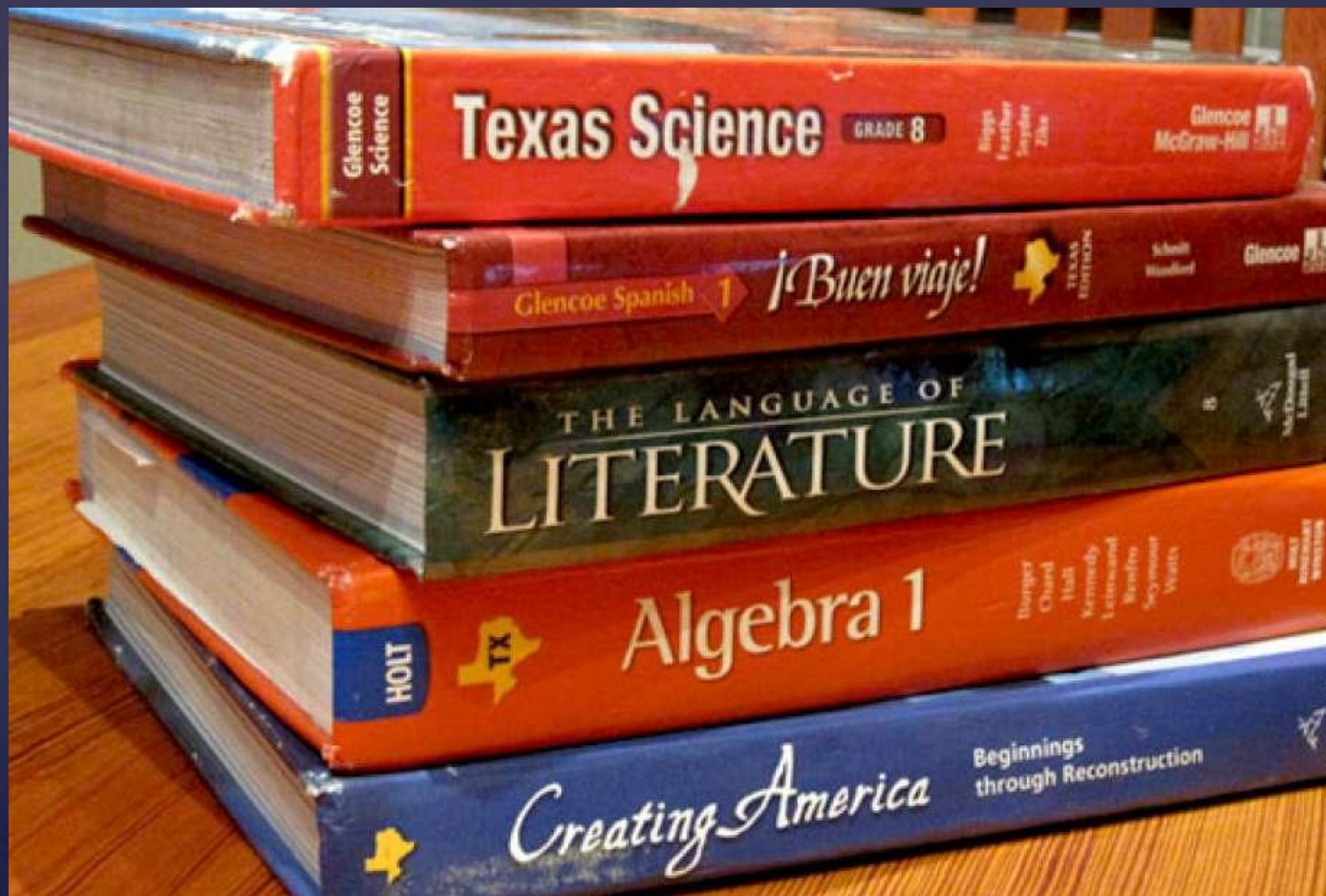
BIOGRAPHY

A story about someone's life



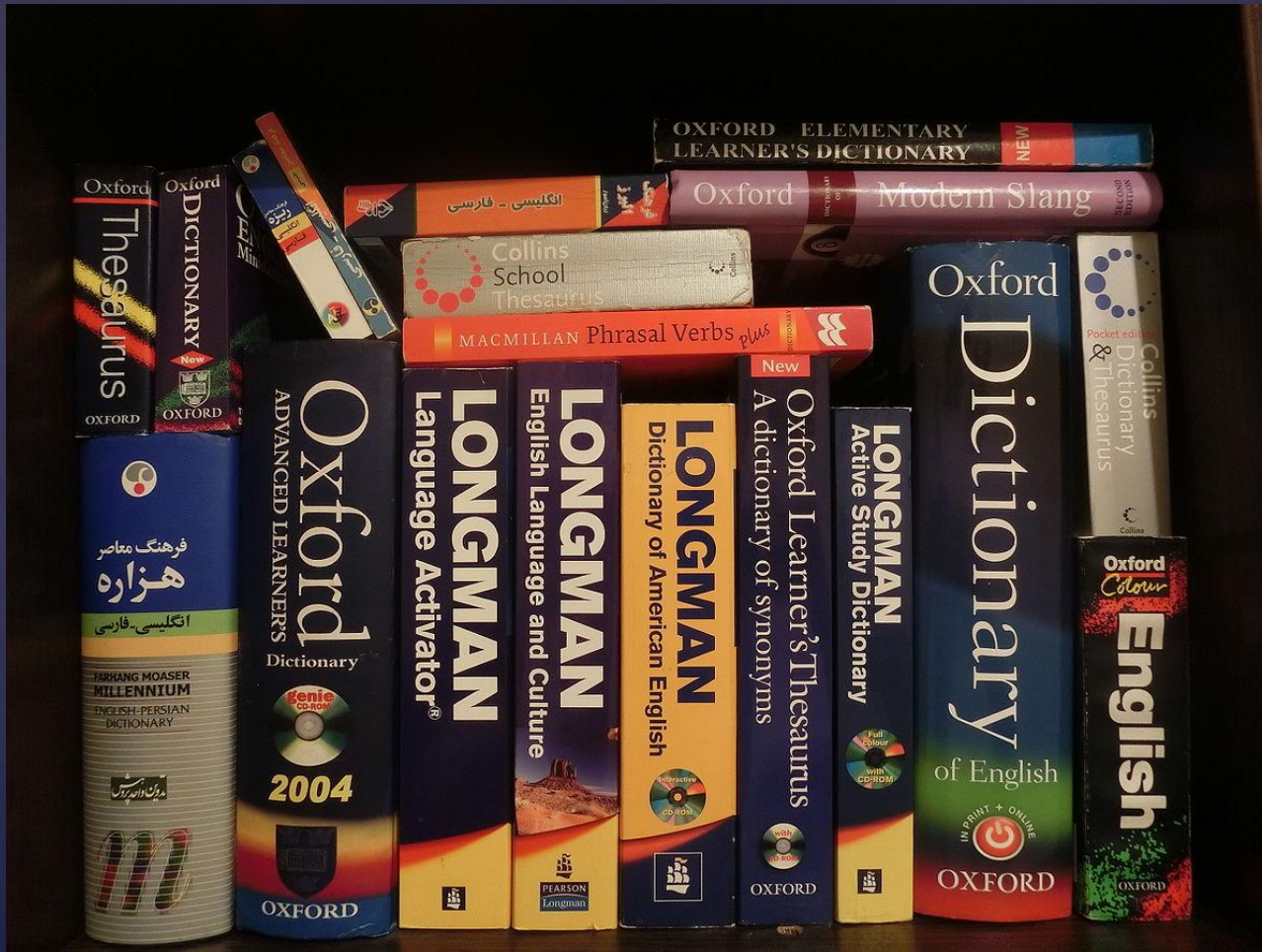
