have got и **has got**?



She **has got** an
apple.

I **have got** an
apple.



He **has got** an
apple.



I **have got** an
apple.



It has **not got**
flowers!

I have **not got**
flowers!



Внимание!

has not got = hasn't got

have not got = haven't got

He **hasn't got** an apple.



She **hasn't got** an apple.



I **haven't got** an apple.



I **haven't got** an apple.

Have I got a dog?

Have we got a dog ?

Have they got a dog?

Have you got a dog?

Has he got a dog?

Has she got a dog?

Has it got a dog?

Have you got a sister?

- Yes, I have (got a sister).
- No, I haven't (got a sister).
