


# TERRORS OF ENGLAND

# HIGHGATE CEMETERY



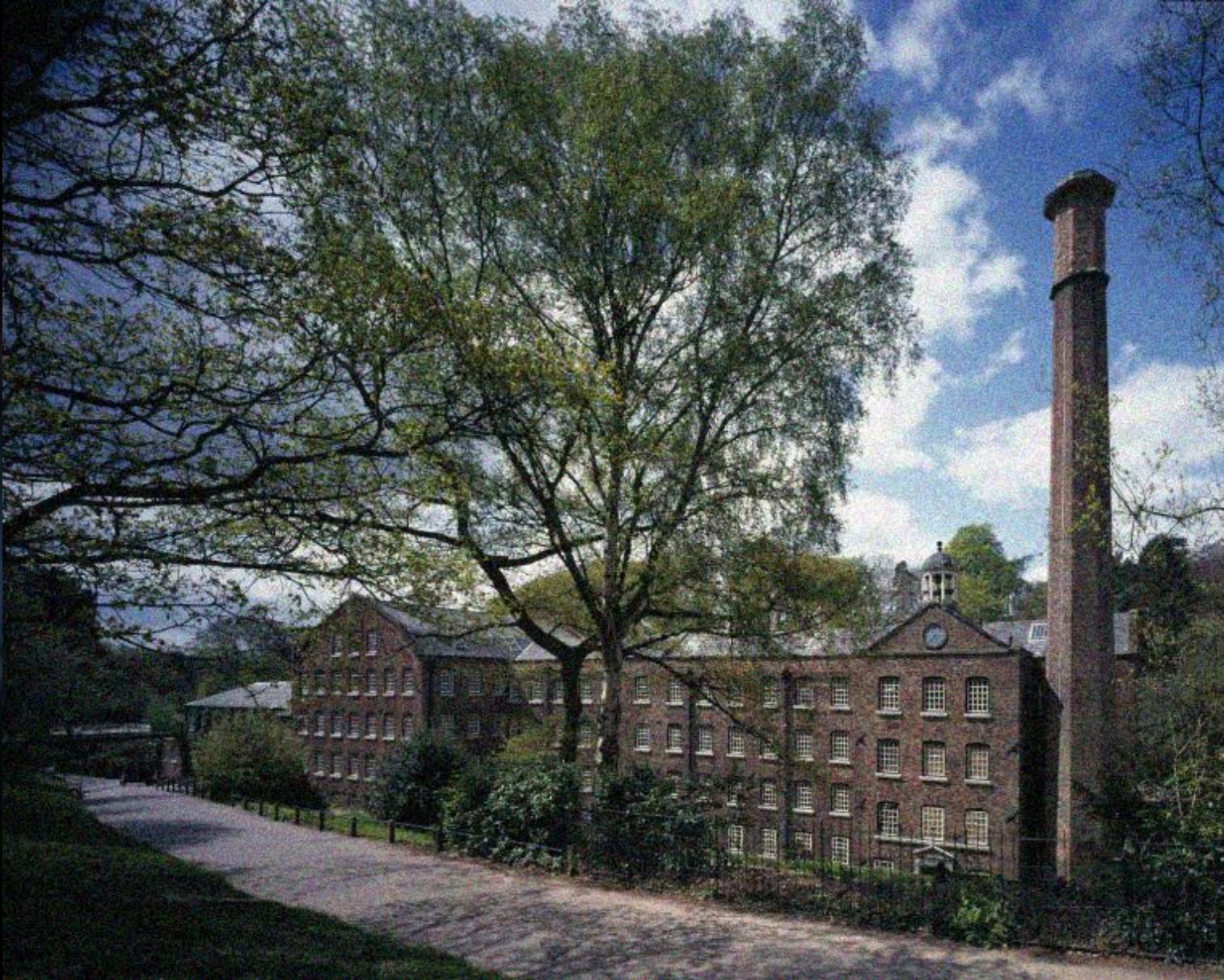
