# Вопрос с «ХВОСТИКОМ»

Представляет собой специфическое предложение, где в левой части – повествование (утвержденное или отрицательное), а в правой части «хвостик», который всегда переводится: «Не так ли?», «Не правда ли?»

# Вопрос с «ХВОСТИКОМ»

Разделительный вопрос призывает собеседника отреагировать на повествование, делает разговор вежливым, уважительный, живым.

Построение хвостика зависит от левой части: если в левой части утверждение, то хвостик будет отрицательным и наоборот.

# Глагол-связка *to be* Present Simple

He is a student, isn't he?



She isn't a student, is she?



They are students, aren't they?



# Запомни!

I am a student, aren't I?



I am not a student, am I?



# Глагол-связка *to be* Simple

Past

Misha **was** a student, **wasn't he**?



Masha **was** a student, **wasn't she**?



Misha and Masha **were** students, **weren't they**?



# Модальные глаголы

Misha can speak English, can't he?



You couldn't speak English last year, could you?



# Глагол “to have”

I have a dog, haven't I?

He has a lesson, hasn't he?

# Смысловые глаголы в будущем времени

Will not = won't

Shall not = shan't

He will read this book tomorrow, won't he?



Mike won't read this book tomorrow, will he?
