The film is based on real events on February 27, 1977 At 21:30. in the evening in one of carriage of the fast train "Youth" going from Moscow to Leningrad there was a fire. And fire has quickly captured all the carriage .

As the doors of the carriage were closed, the cadets of the Leningrad Highest Fire and Technical School who were coming back from a holiday broke windows of the carriage and evacuated the passengers.

During Evacuation Three Cadets — M. B. Zhukov, V. A. Ivanov And Yu. B. Malyshev — died.
