You liked the film, didn't you?


Вам понравился этот фильм , не так ли?
(не правда ли?)

She is a very good pupil , isn't she?


Она очень хорошая ученица, не так ли?

He can't skate, can he?

Он не умеет кататься на коньках , не так ли?



Правила употребления разделительных вопросов

Местоимение



You speak English well, don't you?



**Главное - научиться
выбирать нужные окончания
вопросов!!!**



Если первая часть вопроса утвердительная, то вторая – **отрицательная**, подлежащее заменяется на соответствующее местоимение.

He is a student, isn't he?

Sam is at home, isn't he?

(+), (-)?



И НАОБОРОТ: Если первая часть вопроса отрицательная, то вторая – утвердительная, а подлежащее заменяется на соответствующее местоимение.

He isn't at home, is he?

My friends aren't students, are they?

(-), (+)?



***В предложении
возможно только
одно отрицание (not)!***



Если в первой части предложения есть глаголы **to be (is, am, are, was, were), to have (has, had), will/ shall, can/ could, would/must**, то во второй части предложения используется **тот же глагол**



My brother **IS** a very good doctor,
ISN'T he?

You **ARE NOT** reading now,
ARE you?

Helen **HAS GOT** five kittens,
HASN'T she?

They **HAVEN'T GOT** much money,
HAVE they?

My friends and I **WILL** go to the park
tomorrow,
WON'T we?



Если в первой части предложения нет глаголов **to be** (is, am, are, was, were), **to have** (has, had), **will/ shall, can/ could, would/must**, то во второй части предложения используется **do/ does** или **did** в зависимости от времени действия



You liked the film,

You didn't like the film,

did you?

The sportsmen run very fast,

don't they?

The boy runs very fast,

doesn't he?


