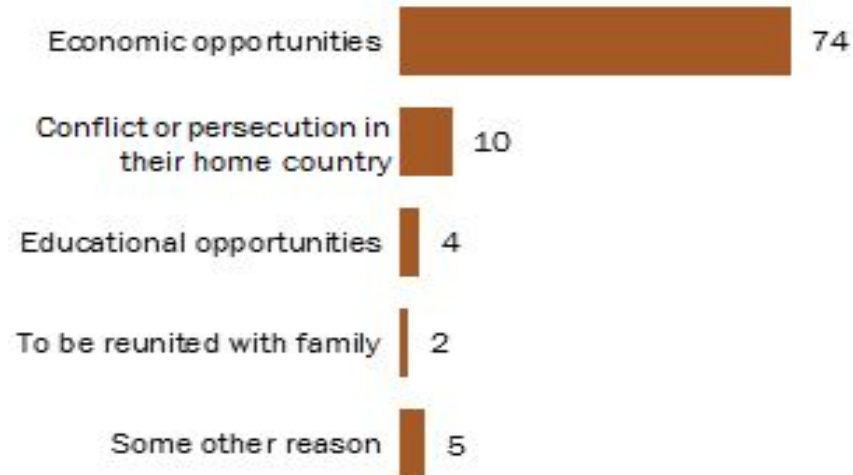

% saying, in their opinion, the main reason most immigrants come to the U.S. is ...



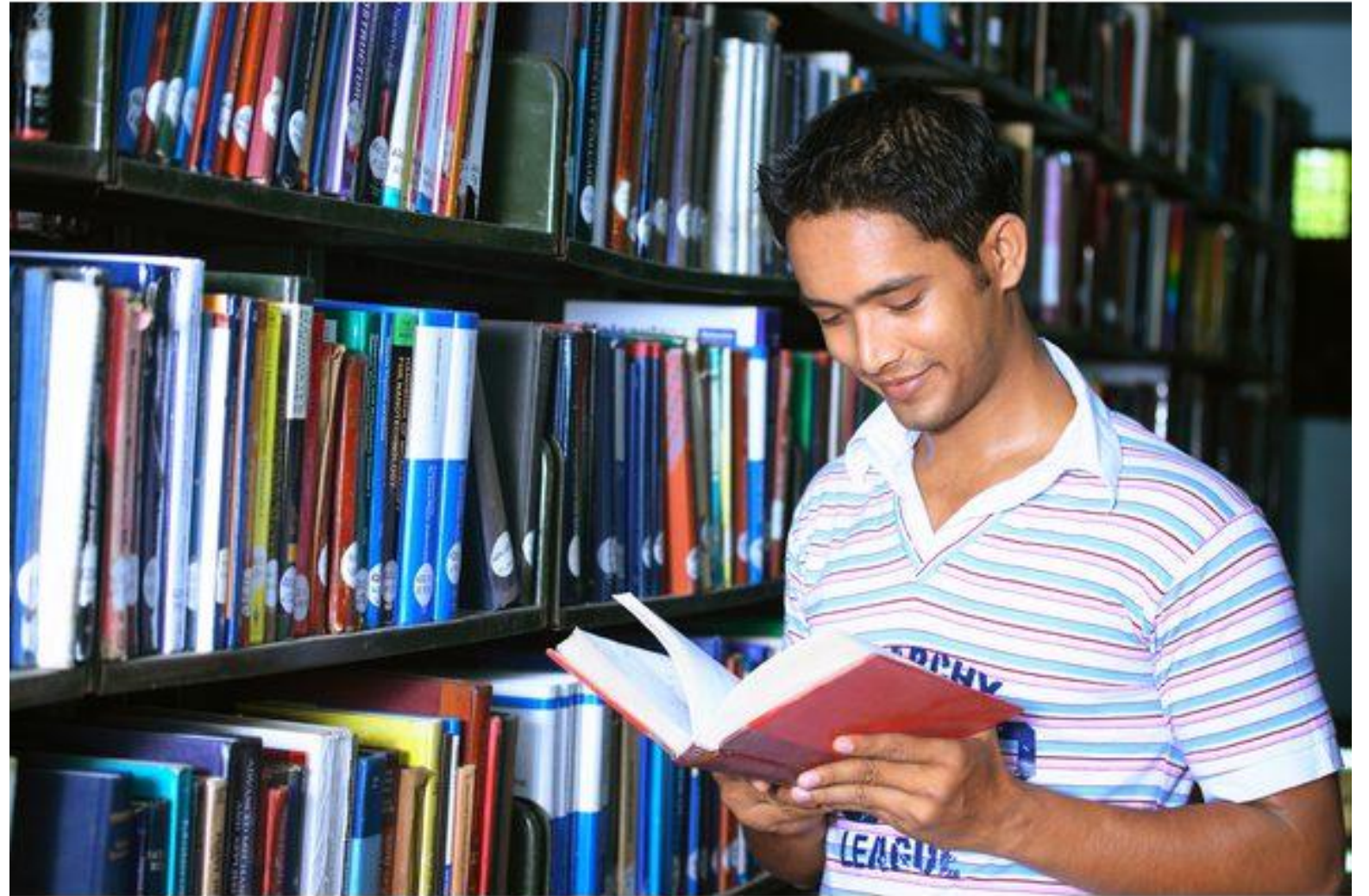

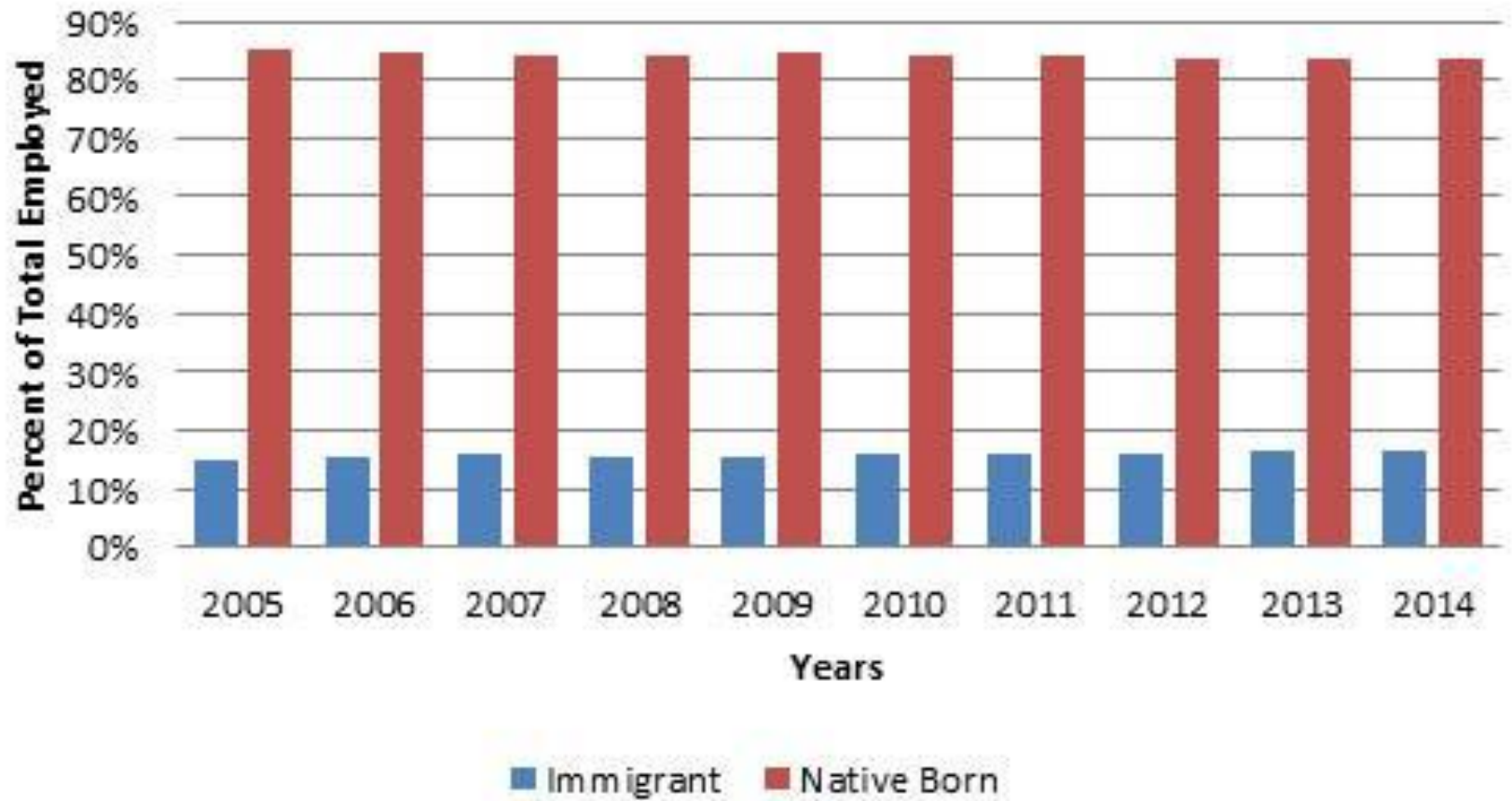
