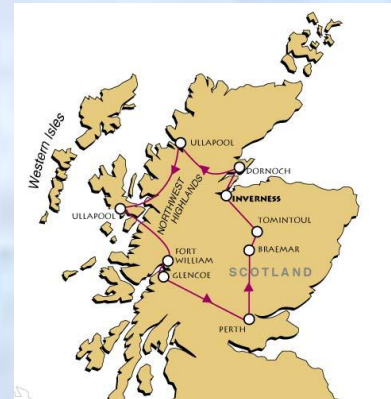

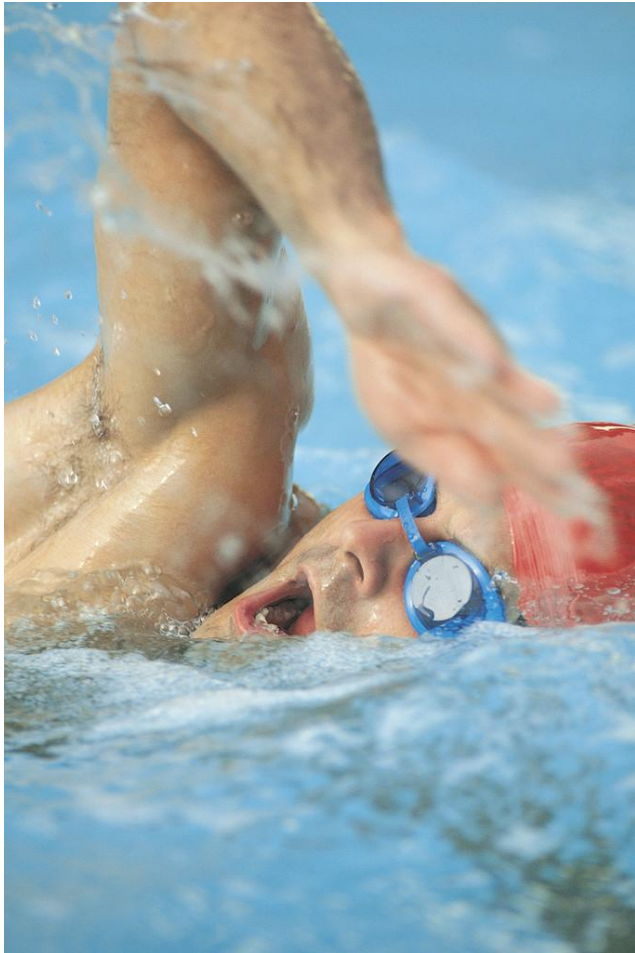
When she saw the monster, Super Nanny was walking.

having a beer.**



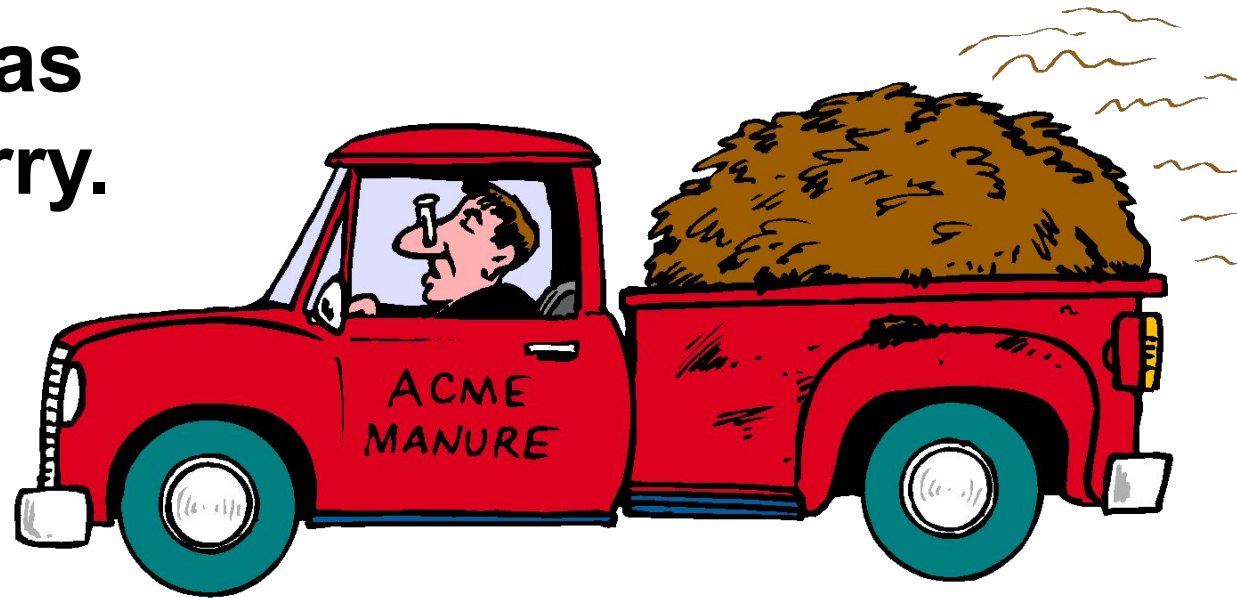


To play football

When I saw the monster, **I was fishing.**



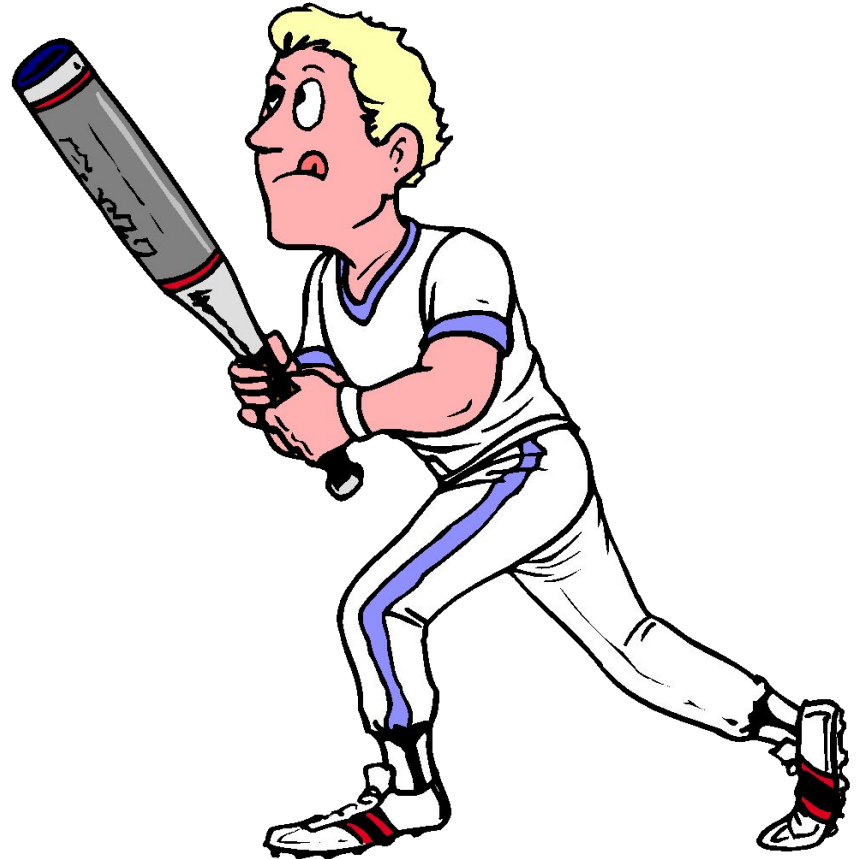
To shout

shouting.**



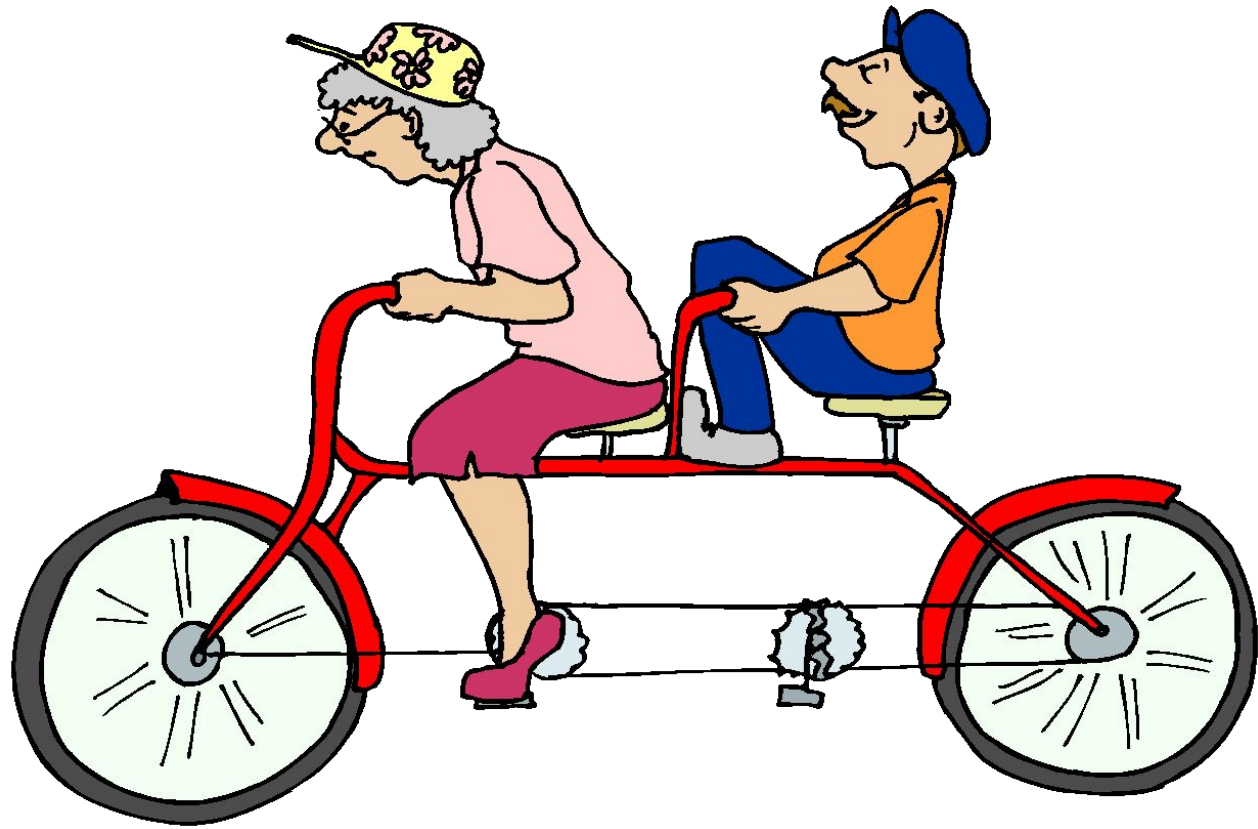
To play baseball

hunting.**



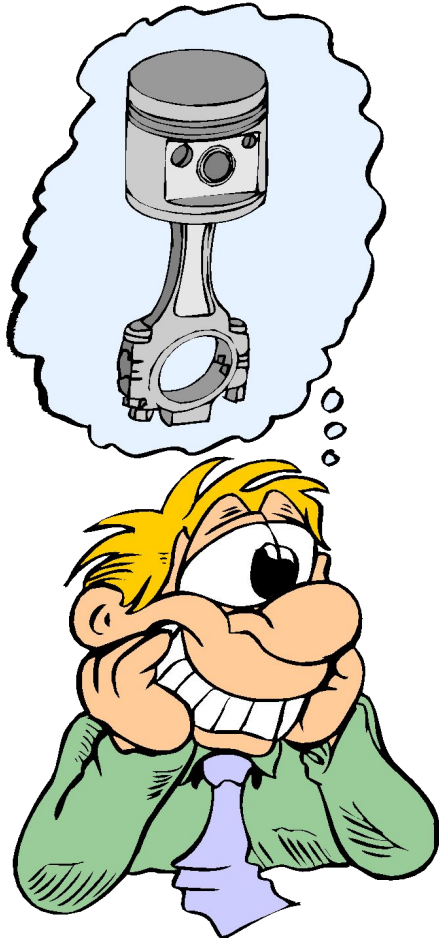
To take photos
