



1. General intro to Arabic language and its different dialects




2. What is Lebanon, the spoken languages

 Lebanon is a small country in the middle east ,<u>Population~3.8 million</u>, <u>Area its 10,452 km²</u>


- its capital is **Beirut**, and its well known for its moderate Mediterranean climate which is located by the side of the Mediterranean sea





- Generally several languages are spoken in Lebanon of which (Arabic, Armenian, Kurdish ,French and English)
- the Lebanese language is mainly Arabic MIXED with French + English + Turkish+ Syriac + Aramaic + Phoenician
- The best comparison example for how close, yet different, Lebanese is from Arabic today, is by comparing the Spanish and Italian languages.
- The people of Lebanon have been updating their language until this very day, enriching it with vocabulary while preserving most of its ancient grammar.


Ethnic composition (2000)


