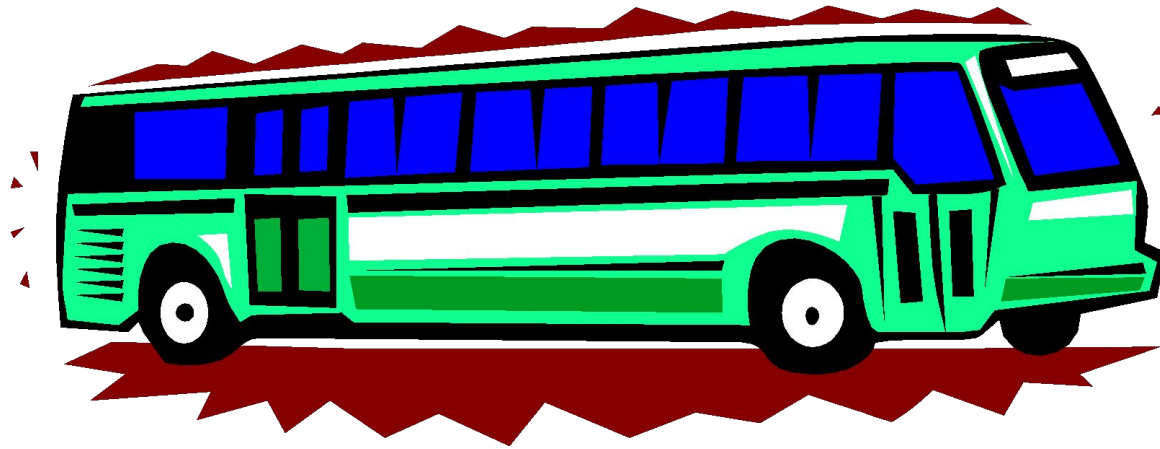


# first conditional for possibilities

\_\_\_\_\_ 'll get (get) wet.

# first conditional for possibilities

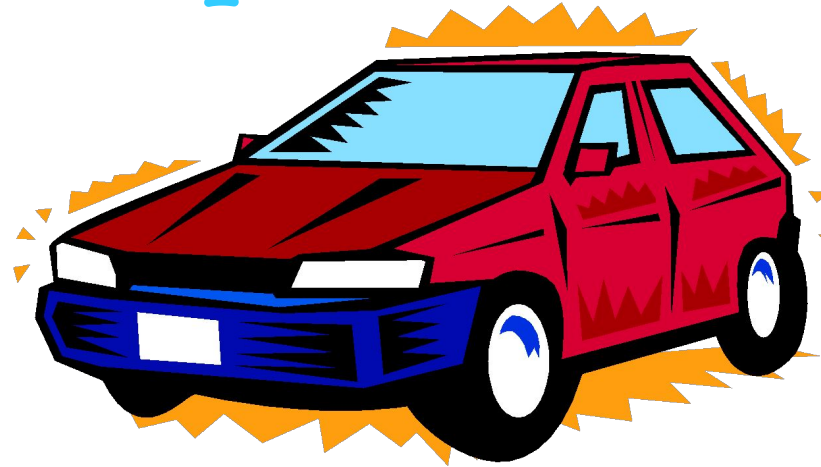


My parents will be(be) angry
