

- Hava an argument

- •Do you have some time to talk?

•HAVE + GOT = HAVE

- •I have three cars = I have got three cars
- •Emma has a sister = Emma has got a sister
- My house is big. It has got five bedrooms
- Daniel doesn't have a car = Daniel hasn't got a car
- •I-YOU-WE-THEY **HAVE** HE-SHE-IT **HAS**
- •I-YOU-WE-THEY **DON'T HAVE** HE-SHE-IT DOESN'T **HAVE**
- •I-YOU-WE-THEY HAVE GOT HE-SHE-IT HAS GOT
- •I-YOU-WE-THEY **HAVEN'T GOT** HE-SHE-IT **HASN'T GOT**

- •DO I-you-we-they HAVE?
- •DOES he-she-it HAVE?
- •HAVE I-you-we-they GOT?
- •HAS he-she-it GOT?
- •Have you got a pen?
- •Has she got a ticket?
- •Have they got a lesson today?

- •All students have to do the exam
- •He hasn't got a car so he has to walk to school every day.
- •Do we have to clean our rooms?
