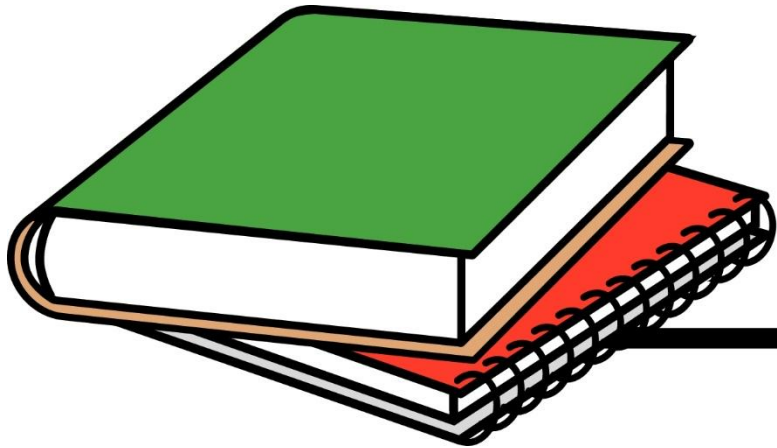

- **Have a good day / a good time**

- **Have an argument**

- **Have some time**

- Do you have some time to talk?

• **HAVE + GOT = HAVE**

- **I have three cars = I have got three cars**
- **Emma has a sister = Emma has got a sister**
- **My house is big. It has got five bedrooms**
- **Daniel doesn't have a car = Daniel hasn't got a car**
- **I-YOU-WE-THEY HAVE HE-SHE-IT HAS**
- **I-YOU-WE-THEY DON'T HAVE HE-SHE-IT DOESN'T HAVE**
- **I-YOU-WE-THEY HAVE GOT HE-SHE-IT HAS GOT**
- **I-YOU-WE-THEY HAVEN'T GOT HE-SHE-IT HASN'T GOT**

- **DO I-you-we-they HAVE?**
- **DOES he-she-it HAVE?**
- **HAVE I-you-we-they GOT?**
- **HAS he-she-it GOT?**
- Have you got a pen?
- Has she got a ticket?
- Have they got a lesson today?

•HAVE TO + VERB

- You **have to** wash your hands before you eat your meal.
- All students **have to** do the exam
- He hasn't got a car so he **has to** walk to school every day.
- Do we **have to** clean our rooms?
