- The first milk chocolate came from a Swiss Manufacture. Daniel Peters was the first to create milk chocolate in 1875.
- Famous brands: Lindt, Toblerone, Cailier, Milka

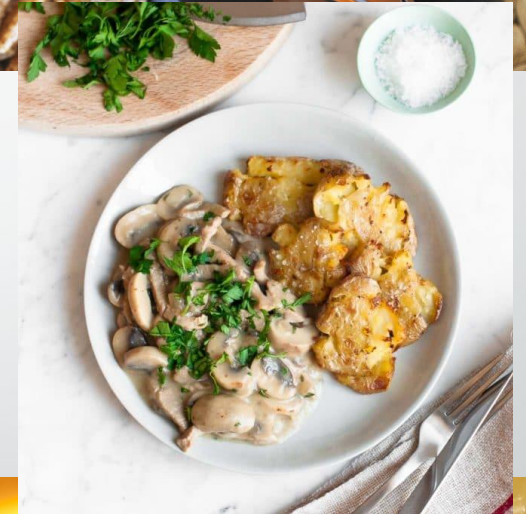




Traditional Foods

- Cheese Fondue: Bread cubes dipped in melted cheese
- Raclette: Melted cheese served with potatoes, pickles and onions
- Röstli: A flat, hot cake made of grated potatoes and fried in hot butter or fat
- Birchermüesli: Oat flakes, lemon juice, condensed milk, grated apples, hazelnuts or almonds. Resembles oatmeal

Veal Zurichoise: A veal dish, made with a cream sauce and mushrooms.
Often accompanied by röstli

Lots of winter ski areals.



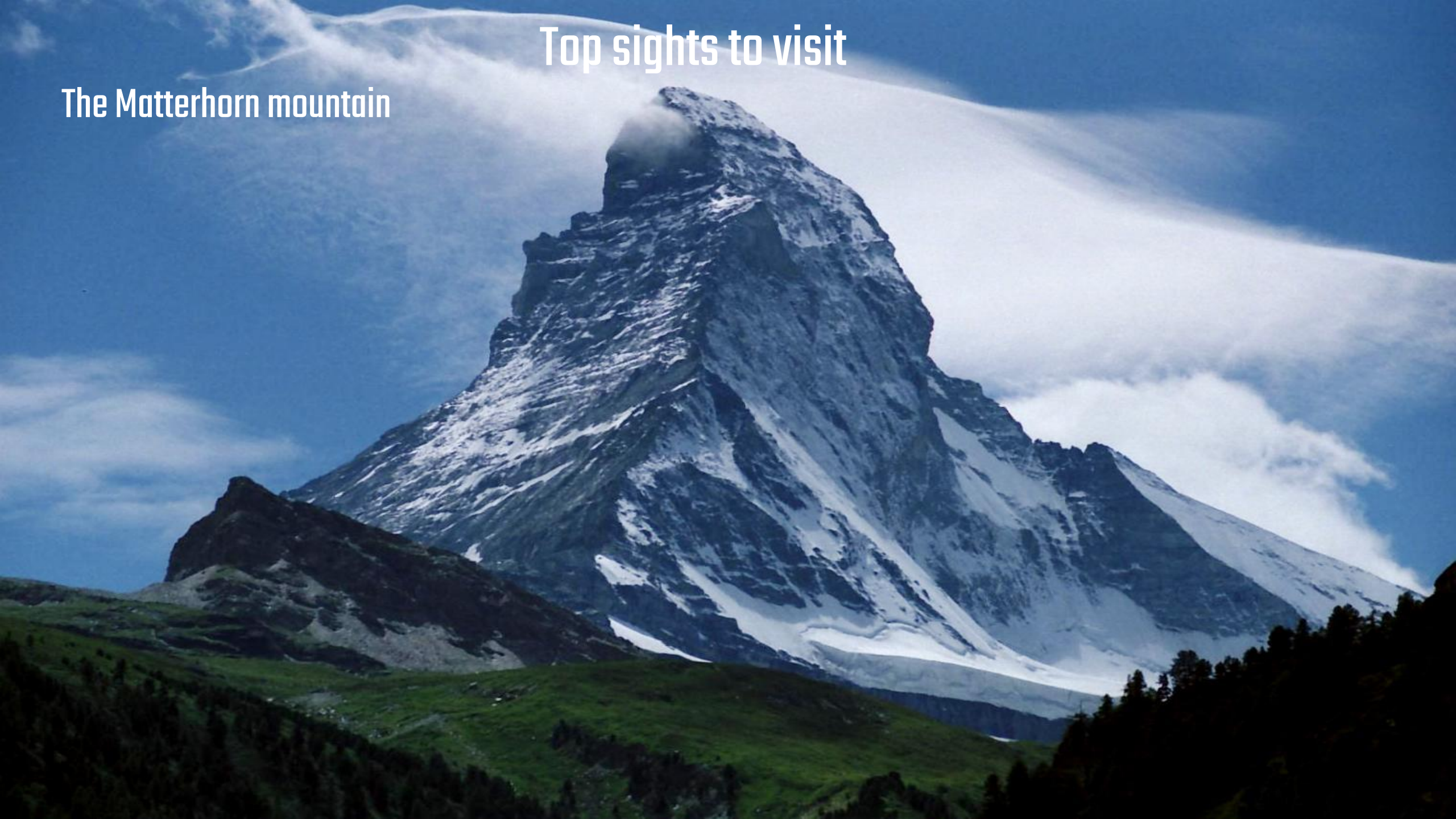
Swiss National Park

- 80 kilometers of hiking paths, nature trails and excursion destinations for children and families; everyone can have a good time.
- The Swiss National Park, founded in 1914, is the oldest in the Alps.
- Is a part of the worldwide UNESCO Biosphere Reserve
- It was one of the earliest national parks in Europe.
