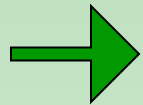
History of Australia

Commonwealth star

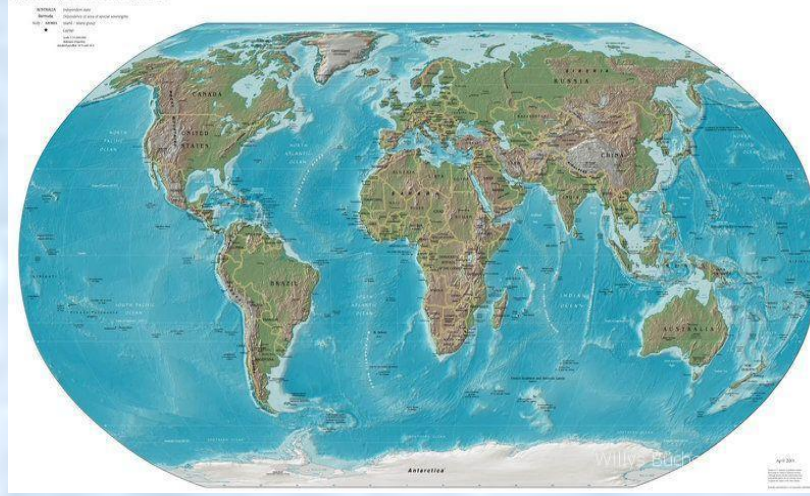

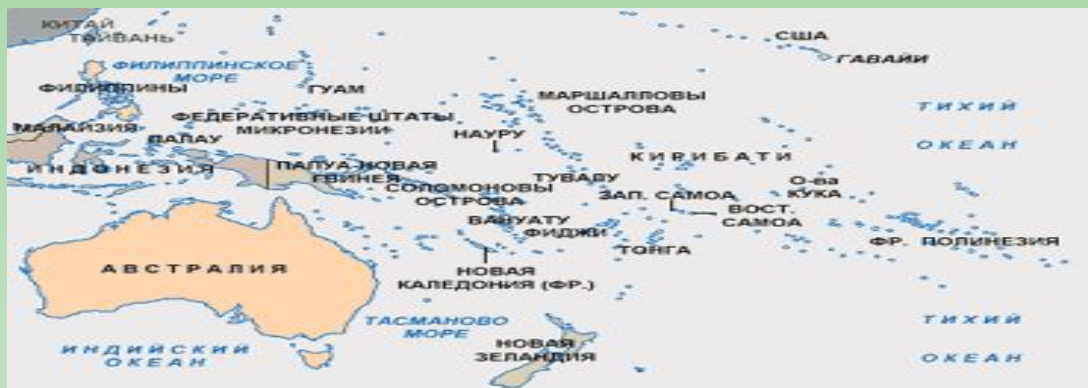
