



BIOGRAPHY


Jorn was born into the family of an architect in Denmark in 1918. His father was a naval architect, had an engineering background and worked as a director at a local shipyard. In 1937-1942 he studied at the architectural school at the Academy of Arts in Copenhagen

After that, Utzon went to Finland to work with Alvar Aalto. He began to admire the ideas of Gunnar Asplund, as well as Frank Lloyd Wright. Over the next decade, the architect traveled a lot, finding inspiration in the Far East, North Africa, the United States, and Mexico.

His first works were a water tower in Svanek (Denmark), a servant's house in the Danish royal castle Elsinor, residential complexes Elineberg and Planettenden in Sweden.






INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION

Danish architect Jorn Utzon was only thirty-eight years old in 1957 when he was named the unexpected winner of the international design competition for the Sydney Opera House in Australia. Its bold design, consisting of five halls topped with billowing concrete sinks lined with ceramic tiles, has universally become recognized as a masterpiece of architecture of the twentieth century.










Conclusion
