How did she escape?

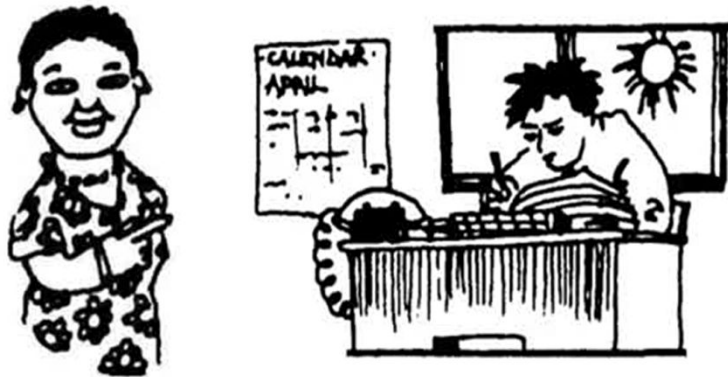
