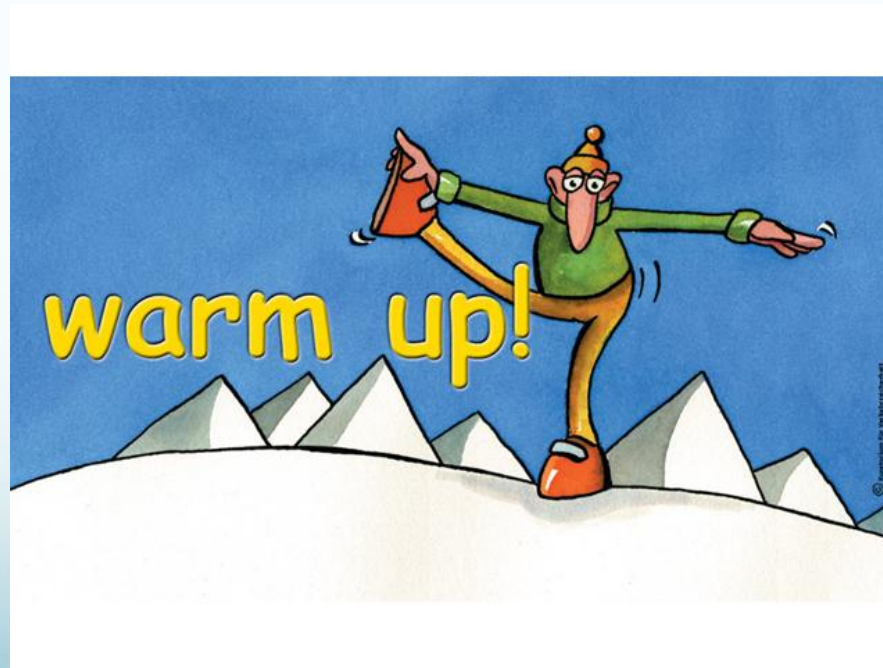

1. **a general question** (starts with ***Do, Did, Can, Is, Are, Would***)
2. **a special question** (starts with ***When, Where, Why, How long, How much, Who, What***)
3. **an alternative question** (contains ***or***)

- Think of the tense
- Avoid complicated questions, focus on accuracy
- Preparation time 1,5 minutes.
- Speaking time 1,5 minutes.

□ Find word clues

1. place, location (start the question with ***Where***)
2. time (start the question with ***When***)
3. duration (start the question with ***How long***)
4. cost, price (start the question with ***How much***)
5. availability (start the question with ***Is there, Are there***)
