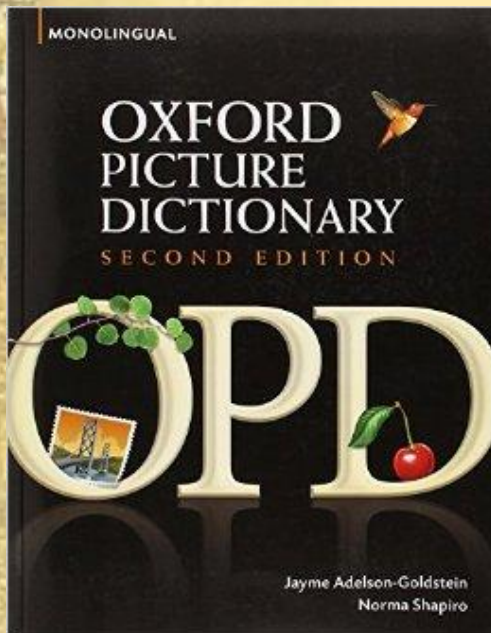

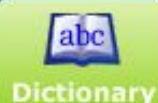

**throw**

 throw something away  
 or out

**throw** UK US *verb* (throws, throwing, threw UK US ) /, has thrown UK US )

**PRONUNCIATION**

 The word **throw** sounds like **go**.

1 to move your arm quickly to send something through the air:

UK US *Throw the ball to Alex.*

UK US *The boys were **throwing** stones at people.*

2 to do something quickly and without care:

UK US *She threw on her coat (= put it on quickly) and ran out of the house.*

3 to move your body or part of it quickly:

UK US *He threw his arms up.*

**throw something away or out** to get rid of rubbish or something that you do not want:

UK US *Don't throw that box away.*

▶ **throw** *noun*:

UK US *What a good throw!*

**thru** UK US (*informal*) American English for **THROUGH**(4)

**thrust** UK US *verb* (thrusts, thrusting, thrust, has thrust)

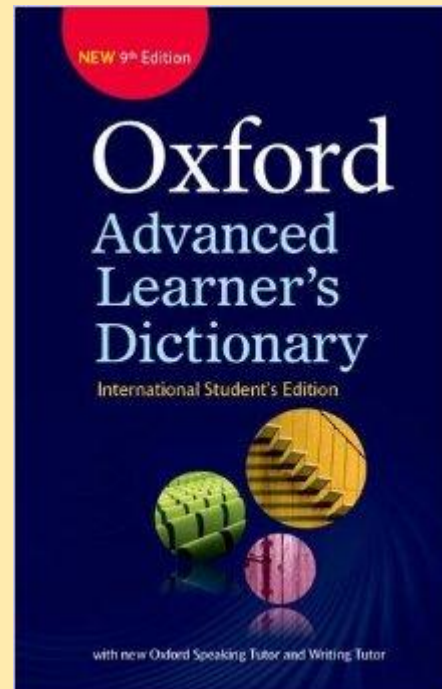
