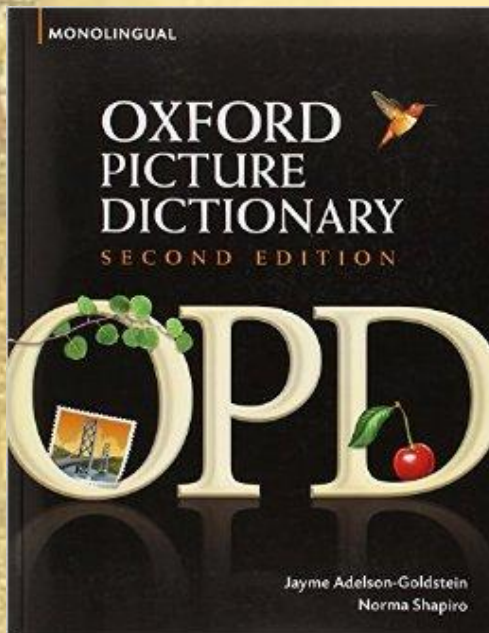

throw something away
 or out



throw   *verb* (throws, throwing, threw  ) /, has thrown  )

PRONUNCIATION



The word **throw** sounds like **go**.

1 to move your arm quickly to send something through the air:



  *Throw the ball to Alex.*

  *The boys were **throwing** stones at people.*



2 to do something quickly and without care:

  *She threw on her coat (= put it on quickly) and ran out of the house.*



3 to move your body or part of it quickly:



  *He threw his arms up.*

throw something away or out to get rid of rubbish or something that you do not want:

  *Don't throw that box away.*

▶ **throw** *noun*:

  *What a good throw!*

thru   (informal) American English for **THROUGH**(4)

thrust   *verb* (thrusts, thrusting, thrust, has thrust)

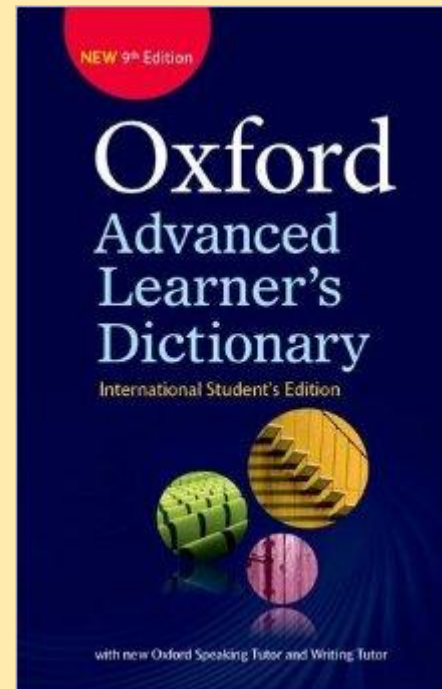
