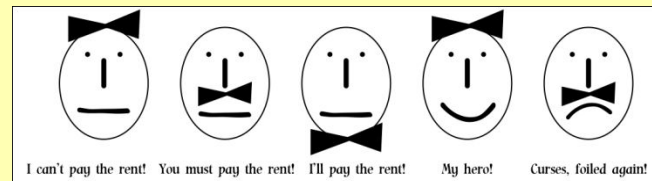


Eight practices for Teaching English

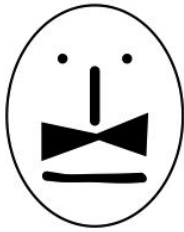
- 1.** Make English learning active and fun

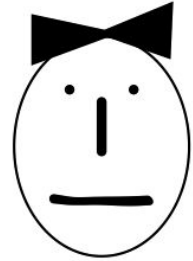

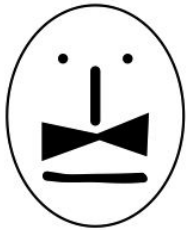

Sample dialogue

Lisa and Rosa run into John on the street.
